REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE,
COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The attached one page of regulations, dealing with occupational licensing fees for mortuary science, is adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development adopts under the authority of AS 08.01.065 and AS 08.42.010, and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

Although no public comments were received, the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes adopted under this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.

Chapter 02. General Occupational Licensing Functions.

12 AAC 02.260 is amended to read:

12 AAC 02.260. Mortuary science. (a) A funeral director or embalmer license and a funeral establishment permit expires on December 31 of all even-numbered years. The following fees are established for funeral directors, embalmers, and funeral establishments:

- (1) nonrefundable application fee for initial license or permit, \$150;
- (2) license or permit fee for all or part of the initial license or permit period, **\$185** [\$275];
- (3) biennial license or permit renewal fee, **\$185** [\$275];
- (4) state law examination fee, \$100.

(b) The following fees are established for funeral director or embalmer trainee permits:

- (1) application fee for initial permit, \$150;
- (2) trainee permit issuance and renewal fee, \$100.

(c) Permit fee for disposal of human remains for compensation by a person not licensed under AS 08.42 is \$75.
