**Christine A. Loffert, Registered Nurse License # 109160 adopted the license Surrender in this matter.**


**This License Surrender takes effect immediately upon signature of this Order in accordance with the approval of the Board.**

The Board adjourned at 4:33 pm until May 3-5, 2017 in Anchorage, Alaska.


