RESOLVED to approve the documentation submitted by Clifford Wilson for his continuing competency audit for the 2016-2018 renewal period, Advanced Practice Nurse Practitioner Authorization No. NURU1055.

In a motion duly made by Wendy Thon and seconded by Linda Hutchings, and carried with 6 ayes, it was

RESOLVED to modify the Consent Agreement for Matthew J. Pavaglio NURR28598 that was accepted at the November 2, 2017 Board of Nursing meeting as follows:

The unsuspended portion of the fine due within 90 days from the date the Board adopted the Agreement is now due within 150 days from the Board adopted the Agreement. All other provision of the Agreement remain as written. This Order modifying the Agreement is a public action of the Board and shall be reported to entities as required by law.


