TELECONFERENCE MEETING
November 20, 2012

By authority of AS 08.01.070(2) and in compliance with the provisions of AS 44.62, Article 6, a scheduled teleconference meeting of the State Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy Board was held on November 20, 2012 at the State Office Building, Conference Room C, Juneau, Alaska.

Tuesday November 20, 2012

Kathy Lind, Chair of the Board of Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy called the meeting to order at 12:06 p.m. This teleconference was called for a quasi judicial meeting for a consent agreement.

Board members present by a voice roll call vote:

The Board of Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy had been provided a copy of the consent agreement which Seanna Bryson signed on November 5, 2012.

Jennifer Wirawan wanted the board to know that on page 4 of the consent agreement, the substance abuse screening states that the respondent will undergo screening within 60 days of the adoption of the consent agreement.

Where the board order and decision made on September 27, 2012 stated within 60 days of the adoption of the order and decision.

The reason for this change is because the consent agreement is more enforceable because Ms. Bryson has agreed to it; if held to the date under the hearing decision, she would be asked to undergo the screening next week, in Soldotna, during the holidays. The date change was to make the consent agreement more enforceable, and that is the only thing that has changed since the decision the board made on September 27th.

Board members, Robinson, Phelps, Parietti, Lind. All agreed the date change was reasonable.

Seanna Bryson has agreed to meet all conditions of the proposed decision and order conditions as outlined at the September 27, 2012 Board meeting in order to be issued a probationary physical therapy assistant license in the state of Alaska.

ON A MOTION MADE BY, MELISSA ROBINSON, SECONDED BY VALERIE PHELPS, THE BOARD EXAMINED THE CONSENT AGREEMENT AND PROPOSED DECISION AND ORDER FOR BOARD CASE # 2012-000039 SEANNA BRYSON. THE BOARD ADOPTS THE CONSENT AGREEMENT AND DECISION ORDER. THE BOARD APPROVES ISSUANCE OF A PROBATIONARY LICENSE

FOR SEANNA BRYSON. IF MS. BRYSON FAILS TO COMPLY WITH ANY TERM OR CONDITION OF THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT, SHE WILL BE IN VIOLATION OF THE AGREEMENT AND HER LICENSE WILL BE SUBJECT TO PROVISIONS AS OUTLINED.


