**Agenda Item – Licensing Examiner Report**

Per the chair’s request, the board’s mission and vision statement is to be read into the minutes at the start of each meeting by the licensing examiner:

*“The Board continues with the goals and purposes of protection of the public; ensuring the public of continued competency of licensed psychology professionals; ensuring psychological care is offered by professionally qualified persons; and ensuring qualified psychology practitioners are available. The Board has approved applicants for licensure as Psychologists and Psychological Associates, as well as monitored continuing education requirements.”*

Logan Bugayong then provided an update on the current number of licensees:

- There are 249 active Psychologist licenses
  - There are 12 active Psychologist Temporary Licenses
- There are 28 active Psychological Associate licenses
  - There is one active Psychological Associate Temporary license
- There are four active Psychologist Courtesy Licenses and all are in good standing

**Agenda Item – Old Business**

In addition, Logan Bugayong provided the board with how many Emergency Courtesy Licenses were issued during the pandemic. These licenses expired on July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

- 71 Emergency Courtesy Licenses were issued to Psychologists

Several ECL holders have been applying for full licensure or are seeking out Courtesy Licenses in order to provide continuity of care. Lacey Derr then presented the end of service report that will be sent to Emergency Courtesy License holders via SurveyMonkey. The Division will be sending out the End of Service Report shortly and the board will use the information gathered as they assess whether they will reenact their emergency regulations. Discussion of the extension of Emergency Courtesy Licenses is to be moved to New Business under “TBD”.

212  
 213 Marvo Reguindin, Executive Director, and Ruddy Taylor, Board President, from the Alaska Psychological  
 214 Association (AK-PA) joined the meeting to provide the board with an update on AK-PA’s business and  
 215 proceedings. AK-PA currently has 106 paid members. 25% of members are students; AK-PA encourages  
 216 student membership and maintaining close relationships with the universities so that they can aid the  
 217 newest generation of psychologists in entering the profession. There is a member of University of Alaska  
 218 Anchorage (UAA) staff on the board of AK-PA to represent UAA. Legislatively, they continue to work on  
 219 the Model Licensure Act. They have found two co-sponsors to present it to the Legislature and their  
 220 offices have begun drafting the language to present at the next session. UAA is also interested in the  
 221 Model Licensure Act and their legislative committee will work on finding ways to collaborate with UAA.  
 222 The board asked about PSYPACT and AK-PA’s stance on psychology compact licensure. Marvo Reguindin  
 223 responded that he does not believe Alaska has yet been approached regarding PSYPACT but as the  
 224 Executive Director of the Washington Psychological Association, he is aware of changes being made to  
 225 the compact legislation. Compact licensure is a topic that is extremely prevalent across several  
 226 healthcare boards in Alaska. AK-PA will provide another update at the November meeting.

327

328 Bradley McConnell presented regarding different license types across jurisdictions. He reported that all  
329 states have a version of a Master’s level practitioner license but it varies what their allowed scope of  
330 practice is, whether they must be supervised, and how long this license can be held across states. The  
331 board has discussed in the past changing the title of a Psychological Associate to something that would  
332 more appropriately indicate their level of training. Alaska’s Psychological Associate is a Master’s level  
333 independent psychologist and this transitioned into the topic of temporary licensure titling. There were  
334 concerns raised that practitioners that hold a temporary license and can only practice under supervision  
335 are advertising themselves as fully licensed psychologists. The Division will look into how many  
336 complaints were filed that pertained to temporarily licensed individuals. The board discussed changing  
337 the name of a temporary psychologist license and temporary psychological associate license to a title  
338 that would indicate their limited scope of practice. The board will be holding a meeting in November  
339 and discussing title changes of temporary licenses and also the regulations change that would be  
340 necessary to require that temporarily licensed psychologists disclose to their clients that they are still  
341 under supervision.

342 The board moved on to discussing SB 21. This bill would introduce a temporary license for military  
343 personnel and military spouses to allow them to work while they are completing the application for full  
344 licensure. The board discussed framing this temporary military license around their Emergency Courtesy  
345 License and elected to have a meeting in September to discuss development of this license. SB 21 will be  
346 put into effect on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

347 Upcoming conference attendance was discussed and given that this is a virtual conference on October  
348 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>, all three board members present will try to attend.
