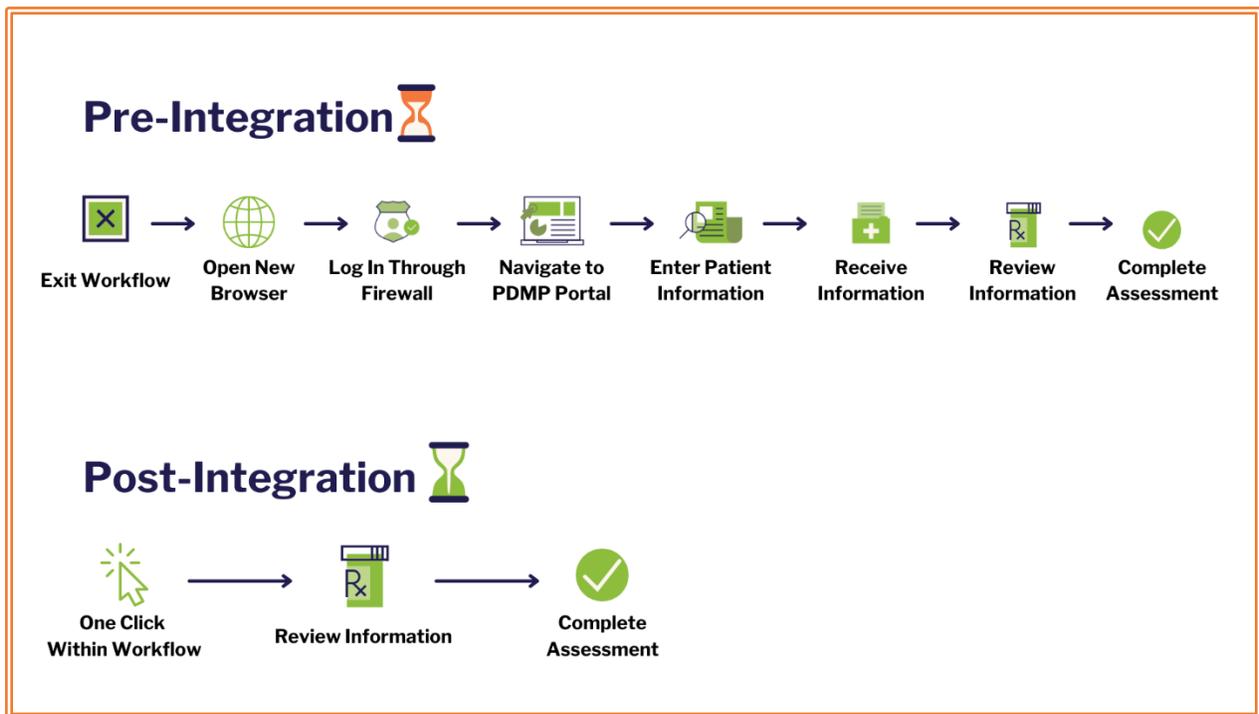


PMP Gateway Integration

The Alaska Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) is now offering PMP Gateway Integration to health care entities through grant funding and partnerships between the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing (CBPL) and the Division of Behavioral Health (DBH).

PMP Gateway Integration provides a streamlined clinical workflow for providers by allowing users to query the PDMP database within an Electronic Health Record (EHR)/Pharmacy Management System (PMS). The integration eliminates the need for providers to navigate to the web portal, log in, and enter the patient's information. Instead, the EHR/PMS automatically initiates a patient query and returns the patient's controlled substance prescription history report directly within the provider's clinical workflow, allowing providers to spend more time on patient care and less time on navigation.
