LICENSING PROCESS

Take the PE Structural Examination

Once registered as a PE in Alaska, applicants may go directly to www.ncees.org to register and take the NCEES PE Structural Examination. Applicant will be licensed as an SE when they have passed the PE Structural Examination, met all other requirements of 12 AAC 36.075, and had their application approved by the board.

MINIMUM TECHNICAL QUALIFICATIONS

Be Currently registered as a PE in AK & 2
years of progressive SE experience

12 AAC 36.075(a)(2 & 4)

AND

Obtain Qualifying Education + Experience
(see table below)

12 AAC 36.075(a)(4)(B)
