The PDMP involves all providers who prescribe or dispense prescription medications. By having all practitioners, including veterinarians, submit data the PDMP can help ensure that all potential sources for abuse or misuse are covered and patient safety is protected.

- 1. Before writing a controlled substance prescription for a federally scheduled II or III drug, you must review the patient's history of controlled substance prescriptions contained in the PDMP.
 - a. The exception(s) are:
 - i. receiving treatment in an inpatient setting;

concerning the PDMP for the Board website.

- ii. at the scene of an emergency or in an ambulance;
- iii. in an emergency room:
- iv. immediately before, during, or within the first 48 hours after surgery or a medical procedure:
- v. in a hospice or nursing home that has an in house pharmacy;
- vi. a nonrefillable prescription of a controlled substance in a quantity intended to last for not more than three days.

- 2. Veterinarians who do not dispense Schedule II-IV medications are not required to report to the PMP.
- 3. If you dispense controlled substances from your practice, create an account and then enter data for dispensed controlled substance https://pmpclearinghouse.net/registrations/new; this data entry can be done by any staff member.
 - To enter a prescription correctly, use the animal's first name, owner's last name, owner's address and animal's date of birth. The date of birth can usually be retrieved from the prescriber or the animal's owner. If you only have the month and year of birth, please be consistent with the dates you use for this specific animal.
 - If no controlled substance are dispensed during the week, the practice should submit a zero report through the account they created with PMP Clearing House.

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 Prescribing (writing out a prescription to be filled by a pharmacy) and administration of medication in a clinic setting are not considered dispensing and, therefore, are not reported.
