5. Work Experience Verification (form 08-4714) with at least 24 months of responsible charge verified by a PE in the discipline in which you are applying. This document, once signed and sealed, *can be accepted electronically* if sent directly from your verifiers to our office;

If you are currently registered and have at least five years post registration professional engineering experience, **in lieu of #5**, you can provide two current letters of reference from US-registered professional engineers registered **in the discipline in which you are applying**. *These can be accepted electronically.* The letters should address:

- Your professional experience on projects;
- Your ability and character;
- The reference's professional association to you;
- How long the reference has been an associate of yours (minimum of 5 years)

7. Arctic and Seismic Requirement (12 AAC 36.110). Application may be submitted and reviewed by the board before the course is completed;
