5. Work Experience Verification (form 08-4716) with at least 36 months of responsible charge. This document, once signed and sealed, *can be accepted electronically* if sent directly from your verifiers to our office;

If you are currently registered and have at least five years post registration professional land surveying experience, **in lieu of #5**, you can provide two current letters of reference from US registered professional land surveyors. *These can be accepted electronically.* The letters should address:
 - Your professional experience on projects;
 - Your ability and character;
 - The reference's professional association to you;
 - How long the reference has been an associate of yours (minimum of 5 years)
- 7. AKLS Requirement (12 AAC 36.100(d)(3)). You must pass the Alaska Land Surveying (AKLS) examination prior to registration. Your application must be reviewed by the board for approval to sit for the AKLS exam, offered in April.
