- 0103-95-10 Single allegation of a previously licensed engineer sealing and signing plans subsequent to the engineer's license lapsing on 12/31/93. (Referred 04/20/99)
- O103-98-3 Single allegation of a previously licensed engineer practicing civil engineering subsequent to his license lapsing on 12/31/97. (Referred 04/20/99)
- O104-96-1 Allegation that a registered land surveyor's work was below the minimum professional standards for a land surveyor. (Referred 08/21/98)
- 0104-98-2 Allegation that a registered land surveyor did not provide services in a timely manner. (Referred 08/21/98)

## **CASES CLOSED:**

- O100-98-1 Single allegation that a licensed architect was not timely and produced an unusable plan. Investigation established that the architect had provided the services contracted for and did not delay the project. Closure reviewed with AELS Board Member Daphne Brown. (Closed 01/04/01)
- O101-98-4 Single allegation that an engineer submitted plan review documents that contained architectural work. Investigation revealed the engineer has prepared documents containing a small amount of architectural work. An advisory letter was sent to the engineer. Closure was reviewed with AELS Board Member Robert Miller. (Closed 10/27/00)
- O101-99-5 Allegation that an unlicensed person has worked as an architect. Investigation revealed the individual referred to himself as an Alaska Architect in his resume, which was distributed as part of a bid for architectural work. The individual was issued an advisory letter and agreed to change the wording in his resume to reflect that he worked under the supervision of a licensed architect. (Closed 11/15/00)
- O102-96-5 Allegation that an engineer was not truthful in a report. Investigation revealed the engineer apparently made a mistake in calculations concerning production of a water well. An advisory letter was sent to the engineer. Closure coordinated with AELS Board Member Robert Miller. (Closed 01/16/01)
- 0102-00-1 Allegation that an engineer was untimely and negligent in the preparation of plans. Investigation failed to substantiate the allegation. Closure discussed with AELS Board Member Robert Miller. (Closed 01/16/01)

- 0104-00-2 Allegation that a land surveyor had not complied with a Board Order. Investigation revealed the land surveyor was in compliance. (Closed 01/02/01)

## **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

O102-00-11 Allegation that Robert D. Schilling, an engineer, committed a violation of professional ethics by failing to comply with a Board Order. Investigation substantiated that Mr. Schilling had not complied with the Board Order and he was seeking renewal of his civil engineer's license. Mr. Schilling entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Division of Occupational Licensing. The MOA calls for Mr. Schilling to pay a fine of \$1,500 (\$1,000 of which was suspended providing he pays the remaining \$500), he is required to attend an ethics course and he was reprimanded by the Board. The Board approved this MOA during the December 28, 2000, teleconference. (Closed 01/02/01)
