Not all pharmacies and dispensing practitioners are required to report federally scheduled II – IV controlled substance prescription data to the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP); however, your account may reflect non-compliance with mandatory data reporting required by AS 17.30.200(r). To assist us in assessing whether you are required to report to the PDMP or to reconcile your account in the AWARxE platform, **please complete this brief survey and return it to this department.**

If the scope of your practice with regards to dispensing controlled substances involves one or more of the below scenarios, you are not required to submit data and your account in PDMP AWARxE will be administratively deleted.
