

ALASKA INSURANCE LEGISLATION PASSED IN 2009

HOUSE BILLS

HB 101 CHAPTER 97 SLA 10

An Act increasing the value of life insurance and annuity contracts that is exempt from levy to satisfy a debt.

Effective Date of Law: September 19, 2010

HB 287 CHAPTER 63 SLA 10

An Act relating to the adoption of the Uniform Disclaimer of Property Interests Act, and to the disclaimer of property rights under the Uniform Probate Code.

Effective Date of Law: September 7, 2010

HB 377 CHAPTER 8 SLA 10

An Act exempting certain volunteer work by amateur sports officials from certain requirements of the Alaska Employment Security Act.

Effective Date of Law: July 29, 2010

SENATE BILLS

SB 10 CHAPTER 117 SLA 10

An Act requiring health care insurers to provide insurance coverage for medical care received by a patient during certain approved clinical trials designed to test and improve prevention, diagnosis, treatment, or palliation of cancer; directing the Department of Health and Social Services to provide Medicaid services to persons who participate in those clinical trials; and relating to experimental procedures under a state plan offered by the Comprehensive Health Insurance Association.

Effective Date of Law: September 29, 2010

SB 163 CHAPTER 103 SLA 10

An Act relating to the duties of the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development and the Fishermen's Fund Advisory and Appeals Council with respect to the fishermen's fund and increasing the allowances for injury, disability, or heart attack payable from the fund, and allowing a vessel owner to recover a portion of the deductible under a protection and indemnity insurance policy following a claim by an injured fisherman; and providing for an effective date.

Effective Date of Law: June 26, 2010

HCR 26 LEGIS RESOLVE 44

Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, concerning Senate Bill No. 163, increasing the allowances for injury, disability, or heart attack payable from the fishermen's fund.

Permanently Filed: August 2, 2010

SB 258 CHAPTER 75 SLA 10

An Act prohibiting health care insurers that provide dental care coverage from setting fees that a dentist may charge under a preferred provider contract for dental services not covered under the insurer's policy, and relating to preferred provider contracts between insurers and dentists.

Effective Date of Law: September 13, 2010
