Kaela was unable to produce proof of any alcohol server education and has worked there more than 30 days.

This is in violation of: AS 04.21.025. Alcohol server education course(a)(c), 3 AAC 305.700. Alcohol server education course(a), AS 04.16.150. Licensee responsible for violations.

AS 04.21.025(a) Except as provided under (e) and (f) of this section, as a condition of issuance or renewal of a license or conditional contractor's permit and selling alcoholic beverages under a license or conditional contractor's permit, the board shall require a licensee or permittee who sells or serves alcoholic beverages and a licensee's or permittee's agents and employees who sell or serve alcoholic beverages or check the identification of a patron to complete an alcohol server education course approved by the board.

(c) A licensee, permittee, agent, or employee shall complete the course required under (a) of this section and pass a written test, online or in person, demonstrating an understanding of the course subjects not more than 30 days after being licensed, permitted, or employed. The course provider shall issue a card to each individual who completes the course and passes the written test. A card issued under this subsection is valid for three years from the date of issue. A licensee, permittee, agent, or employee may renew a card issued under this section; to renew the card, the licensee, permittee, agent, or employee must pass a written test demonstrating an understanding of the course subjects. Notwithstanding the 30-day period 95 for completing the course and passing the written test under this subsection, a person may not sell or serve alcoholic beverages or check the identification of a patron at a permitted event under AS 04.09.600 - 04.09.690 unless the person possesses a valid card issued before the event.

3 AAC 305.700. Alcohol server education course. (a) Unless exempt under AS 04.21.025(f), a licensee, employee, or agent of a licensee selling or serving alcoholic beverages shall successfully complete an alcohol server education course. The person or the on duty supervisor shall carry or have available to show current course cards or photocopies of the cards certifying completion of an approved alcohol server education course. The card is effective for three years from the date of issuance during which time the person shall complete another approved course or successfully complete a written test demonstrating an understanding of the course subjects as required by AS 04.21.025(c). The card must include the name and date of birth of the card holder, the name of the course, and the date of expiration of the card. If the card does not include a photograph of the holder, the person shall also carry a valid identification under 3 AAC 305.800(b). The card or a photocopy of the card must be shown upon request of a peace officer or board representative. If the person cannot show a current card or a copy of it on file on the premises or show a date of hire less than 30 days earlier, the person shall immediately cease selling or serving alcoholic beverages or checking identification.

Good morning,

The Controlling Interest Transfer has been effectuated and nothing additional is needed from the current licensee at this time. Unfortunately, the Transfer application that was filed did not indicate that there was supposed to be a retained security interest. It was not advertised in that way nor mentioned in paperwork or correspondence for the Transfer. There is no way to apply a security interest to a Transfer that has already been effectuated.

The Transfer application was sent to AMCO Enforcement in the afternoon on 11/12/2025 to finalize the Transfer, and the NOV (AMCO Case #: AM-25-1802) was issued that same day. From what I can tell, Enforcement was already in the area for a routine inspection prior to their notice of the Transfer. At the time the NOV was issued, the Transfer had not yet been effectuated, and you were still the licensee of AVO Hospitality, LLC. The NOV does list your name, like a sole proprietor, on the NOV instead of AVO Hospitality, LLC as the licensee. You could potentially ask if the NOV can be amended, but that would have to be communicated with AMCO Enforcement, and any further questions regarding the NOV should be brought up with them. I am writing in response to the violation notice regarding the inspection conducted on April 16, 2026.

At the time of hire, employee K. Stuart held a valid server education certification. Unfortunately, her certification expired on March 6, 2026, and this lapse was not identified prior to the inspection. While the employee is responsible for maintaining her certification, I fully recognize that as the licensee, I hold responsibility for ensuring that all staff serving alcohol have current and valid server education.

Upon notification of the violation, immediate corrective action was taken. K. Stuart was instructed to cease alcohol service immediately and complied with that directive. She completed her required server education training on April 20, 2026, and provided proof of certification before returning to work on April 22, 2026.

This incident does not reflect the standards I strive to uphold within my establishment. I take compliance obligations seriously and have implemented additional internal controls to prevent recurrence. Specifically, I have implemented a system to track employee certification expiration dates and will require periodic verification to ensure all server permits remain current at all times.

While I acknowledge prior disciplinary history within the past five years, I respectfully submit that this matter was the result of an isolated oversight rather than a willful disregard of the law. The prompt corrective action taken, along with the enhanced compliance measures now in place, demonstrate my good-faith commitment to adhering to all applicable regulations moving forward.

Ruiz stated that he couldn't find the card and that his boss would email a copy of it to me after the lunch rush. I never received an email.

On 5/20/26 I phoned Licensee Andrew Cho. Mr. Cho stated he checked Ruiz's server education and it was expired as of January of 2026. I emailed CHARR to confirm that the server education is expired and CHARR confirmed it expired on 1/5/26.

Ruiz emailed me a copy of a certificate of completion of the Alcohol Server Education course offered by CHARR dated 4/20/26. In the email he stated that he "ended up needing to renew it." Ruiz was issued a citation for failure to comply with alcohol server education requirements.
