Greetings Licensee,

Renewals of alcoholic beverage licenses with or without endorsement(s) start November 1, 2025.

Here is where you can check which of your licenses need renewal

<https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/amco/AlcoholLicenseApplication.aspx>. You can apply for 2026/2027 renewal through AK-ACCIS <https://accis.elicense365.com/#>.

As of December 27, 2024, an application for renewal of an alcoholic beverage license with or without endorsement(s) must contain the doing-business-as name the licensee uses for the alcoholic beverage establishment. If you do not have a state issued business license under AS 43.70

<https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/cbpl/BusinessLicensing.aspx>, you must obtain a business license as set forth under 3 AAC 305.050(c)(8).

As of October 25, 2024, a fee of \$150.00 is required for an application submitted on a paper form that was otherwise available to the applicant for submission through AK-ACCIS as set forth under 3 AAC 305.165(10).

Fees may be paid in three ways,

1. When you apply online, you may pay through AK-ACCIS by credit or debit card.
2. You may email us at alcohol.licensing@alaska.gov or call us at (907) 269-0350 to request to pay by e-bill.
3. You may mail in a personal check, business check, cashier's check, or money orders. Make your checks or money orders payable to the State of Alaska or AMCO and mail to AMCO, 550 W. 7th Avenue, Suite 1600, Anchorage, AK 99501.

Applications postmarked, emailed, or submitted through AK-ACCIS later than 11:59 pm on Wednesday, December 31, 2025, will be assessed a \$500.00 non-refundable late fee in addition to the regular renewal fees, as set forth under AS 04.11.270(b)(3).

Any application and required fees not postmarked, emailed, or submitted through AK-ACCIS by February 28, 2026, will result in expiration of the alcoholic beverage license, as set forth under AS 04.11.540.
