

Guidelines for Tourism License AS 04.11.400(d)

Please provide a "tourism statement" with your renewal application. The guidelines at the bottom of this page will assist in forming the statement. The ABC Board is requiring all tourism liquor licenses to fulfill the regulation below by providing the Board with a statement demonstrating how your establishment encourages tourism. Please attach the statement to the renewal application and submit the package to the ABC Board office. Thank you for your cooperation.

3 AAC 304.325. License issued to encourage tourism.

(a) The board will, in its discretion, approve the issuance or transfer of location of a beverage dispensary or restaurant or eating place license under AS 04.11.400(d) only upon a showing that

(1) the approval will encourage the construction or improvement of a tourist facility which would not be financially feasible without a liquor license; and

(2) construction or improvement of the tourist facility will encourage tourism, and tourist business will constitute a substantial portion of the business of the tourist facility.

(b) Repealed 10/24/87.

(c) The licensee must show, upon application for renewal, that issuance of the license encouraged tourism, that the facility was constructed or improved in accordance with the application, and that the facility continues to be operated by the licensee. If the licensee does not make the showings required by this subsection, renewal will be denied.

Guidelines:

1. Explain how your establishment "encourages tourism".
2. Do you offer room rentals to the traveling public? If so how many of these rooms are available?
3. Do you offer food service?
4. Do any of your rental rooms have kitchenettes (defined as: a sink for food preparation along with refrigeration and cooking appliance devices, including a microwave)? If yes, how many?
5. Are additional amenities available to your guests through your establishment (e.g. guided tours or trips, rental equipment for guests, other activities that attract tourists)?
