Dear Sir/ Madam:

We represent Petro Alaska, Inc., which holds ABC License # 3315. We have been informed that, while that license is "Active" through December 31, 2014, Petro Alaska may not use or transfer the license because it failed to obtain the necessary waiver. For reasons we explain below, the Company is in the unfortunate position of needing a 4th and final waiver. We regret Petro Alaska's omission in not timely seeking this last waiver, but believe that compelling circumstances explain and mitigate the late request.

The answer, in short, is litigation. We have represented two of the Petro Alaska's shareholders in litigation since late 2006 and the Company since mid-2008. During 2007 through 2009, the Company and its shareholders were engaged in extended litigation over the Company's primary asset, its property in Ketchikan. It was on that property that the Company used the liquor license.

In 2009, the trial court dismissed the shareholders' and Company's remaining claims, which dismissal they timely appealed. Since then, the Company has been in something of a "limbo" – waiting to hear the results of its appeal. While engaging in an orderly liquidation of assets and paying debts, some matters, such as the liquor license, remained problematic. After 2011, the Company no longer owned the property on which it had previously used the license, and it sought to sell the license. Meanwhile, the Company was preserving remaining cash for ongoing litigation if the appeal were successful. The Company never anticipated the appeal would take so long. By the time the Supreme Court finally decided the appeal, remanding some of the Company's claims for trial, four years had passed since the dismissal (making the case the oldest or second oldest on the Supreme Court's docket).

Since the remand, the Company has been preparing to try the remaining claims while winding up its remaining business affairs. It now, finally, has a chance to transfer its Liquor License and gain some benefit from its long maintenance of it. Accordingly, we respectfully request that the ABC Board grant the Company this final waiver of License # 3315. Thank you for considering this request.

This office represents Hong & Lees, Inc. and Robert Alexander relative to the aforementioned Notice of Violation. This letter will provide you with an overview of the events leading up to this violation and our client's actions in dealing with the factual matters asserted in the NOV. My client takes these matters extremely seriously and will continue to work hard to insure compliance with Title 4 to the letter. Unfortunately, sometimes licensees are truly unaware of the legal ramifications of their actions or of actions taken by others without their knowledge or consent.

I will address each of the allegations contained in the Notice of Violation separately. First, the Notice of Violation asserts that Hong & Lees, Inc. has relinquished "right, title, and interest" in their liquor license in violation of Title 4. As I believe was told to Investigator Hamilton in interviews with my clients, the license was never rented. The restaurant and kitchen were leased. The bar was run under a management agreement that was contained within the lease. Please see Section 4 of the Lease entitled "Lounge Management Fee." While this clause is not an extensive agreement, it is a management agreement for all intensive purposes. Further, my clients filed a modification of that lease on February 6, 2014 in an effort to clear up this matter. In an effort to avoid all question of the legality of the arrangement, I have advised my client to separate the two transactions and to execute a more complete and formal management agreement. As such, please be advised that we will be submitting a more sophisticated and clear management agreement to you within the next 10 business days. I believe that once this is completed, any question about the legality of this licensing arrangement will be resolved. Further, it is my recommendation that a new and clear premise diagrams be filed with the ABC Board as I believe that a proper management agreement and clearly delineated premises will clear up all of the legal issues relative to this arrangement.

Second, the NOV states that my client's bouncers were operating without a TAMM card as required by MOA law. The bouncers were hired under a contract with a private security firm. As such, my client improperly assumed that the bouncers would have all of the requisite training required by law. Even though they had only been employed for 2 weeks, my clients made an oversight by not confirming with the company providing security that TAMM training had been completed by the bouncers in question. My clients are committed to doing even more to prevent future violations. As such, my clients will continue to implement policies and provide supplemental training to insure that all of their employees conduct themselves in a professional, accountable, and legal manner.

Lastly, the NOV asserts that my clients were advertising "free champagne" at a DJ hosted event in 2013. For the record, let's be very clear. My clients have never served free alcohol of any type. Here, a hired DJ took it upon himself to promote his show at my client's facility on Facebook. This ad promoting his show was never approved or sanctioned in any way by my Since my client was unaware of these representations and was surprised to hear that such an ad had been even run, my client has drastically altered the way it does business with its entertainers. From this point forward, no advertisements of any kind will be allowed by anyone without prior management approval. The ABC Board and staff should rest assured that my clients understand the requirements of Title 4 relative to drink specials and that at no time were free drinks given to patrons.

Please let me know if you feel that an in person meeting is necessary to discuss these issues. Thank you for your time and courtesies in this matter and should you have any questions or concerns about these matters, please feel free to contact me at anytime.

Director Cote',

We are writing in response to a notice of violation that occurred in the Mecca Bar on March 1, 2014. I have given my staff the following tools and implemented the following new policies in an effort to prevent any future violations.

The violation occurred as a result of a Military ID being misread. In the future it will be the policy to require a second form of ID along with any military ID presented to our bartenders. I have also made several copies of all Military ID's available with the birthdates highlighted so there will be no confusion. All bartenders signed a memo of the new policy and it will be placed in their files. There are also several ID books and placards for the bartenders to double check if they have any questions about an ID's validity. We will continue our policy of not accepting the vertical "Under 21" ID.

We have placed the Born on calendar by the main register along with the stickers placed along the bar. There are also two other signs placed behind the bar with the proper serve date displayed to be easily read. We have installed brighter lighting and put flashlights behind the bar. I have also purchased several magnifying glasses to aid in the reading of the smaller numbers.

We spent time with Darlene Workman going through the TAP training manual and the entire ID checking material that I have made available. We have revisited all of the bar policies about checking ID's and the new policy on the Military ID's. On a personal level she has been advised to bring the tools she needs to properly perform her duties, i.e. reading glasses.

After the February 23, 3014 incident occurred, Four Corners Lounge management called an employee meeting to review company policies and procedures in order to ensure this type of incident does not happen again. Methods to help our employees evaluate if an individual is intoxicated were reviewed. Emphasis is being put on added diligence in trying to establish a dialogue with patrons and closer observations to ensure patrons are not intoxicated. An effort will also be put on trying to serve food to patrons in conjunction with their alcohol beverage. If it is determined that an individual is intoxicated, a cab will immediately be called to ensure the patron is taken home.

Four Corners Lounge Inc. takes the regulations and requirements associated with being the licensee of an alcoholic beverage dispensary license very seriously. We ensure all employees have taken and are current with their Alcohol Management Certification (TAMS) training. This training strongly emphasizes the need and importance of ensuring that patrons have not overly imbibed on alcoholic beverages. In addition to TAMs training and regular discussions about evaluating customer's condition, Four Corners Lounge has a written policy regarding not serving inebriated individuals and that violating this policy is grounds for immediate dismissal.

Four Corners Lounge Inc. feels that this was an isolated incident by an employee who did not pay close enough attention to a customer. I am in receipt of your Notice of Violation dated March 27, 2014. On the March 22, 2014 I made the mistake of serving an alcoholic beverage to an individual who was under the age of 21. I have actually implemented a policy at the restaurant to check identifications of anyone who looks under the age of 40. I even checked the identification of the person who was participating in the sting operation. My only explanation for what happened that night is that I was distracted and miscalculated her age despite seeing her birthdate.

I would just like to say that it is never my intention to profit from sales of alcohol to underage people. I have learned from this experience that when checking identifications, I must not rush and make certain that the individual who is being served alcoholic beverages is of lawful age. In order to prevent this from occurring again, I have decided to implement a system for checking identifications that require checking the birthdate on the identification against the calendar to make certain that the person is at least 21 years old. Regardless of how busy the restaurant is, I will make sure that the identifications that are checked are thoroughly reviewed to avoid making this same mistake again. I am glad that my habit of checking identifications has been working well however, I realize the importance of calculating the age correctly once I have checked the document stating the age of the person.

As this was not a willful violation of the statute governing this incident, I would respectfully request that the board show leniency when considering my punishment. I am a law abiding citizen and am very careful when operating my business. In this specific instance, I did not fail to check the identification of the individual but rather made the simple mistake of miscalculating the individual's age.

This was an honest mistake that could have happened to anyone. The fact that I checked the person's identification to verify lawful age should be considered when evaluating my actions. I ask you again to please consider showing leniency in the case at hand. Should you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me directly.

I am writing in response to the Notice of Violation I received in the mail on 3/20/14. dispensary license #3195.

I recently lost a manger that had been working for me for many years just prior to the incident on 1/18/14 where a minor was allowed entrance to the Blue Loon and subsequently served. My understanding was that the manager had trained all security personnel and had insured that they had a current TAMS or TIPS card. I realize that ultimately it is my responsibility and am not using this as an excuse.

As to the two persons listed on the violation as door personnel both of them now have current TIPS cards. Mr. Jones had never had one before and only recently worked the main entrance due to being short staffed, he usually works the main room where the bands play. Mr. St. John has had a TAMS card before but it had expired. I believe he declined to tell that to the enforcement officer.

From now on all security staff will have to have a current TIPS card. Currently every person that checks ID at the main entrance has a current card including our cashier. Every person who works security staff will need to have a TIPS card to continue to work at the Blue Loon.

Turnover is sometimes high and often I have to hire staff who don't have a TIPS card but they will need to get one in the first 30 days of employment or will not be able to work. I've told every staff member about this new policy.





On January 18, 2014, our Customer Service Associate, Christopher Glenn Jackson, was found to have sold an alcoholic beverage to a person under the age of 21 and thereby violated AS 04.16.052. As you know from past experience, this is a very serious matter for us since we work very hard to ensure that we perform all restricted age sales in a proper manner.

Christopher Glenn Jackson was employed by Tesoro starting on April 08, 2013 and ending on January 22, 2014. He received appropriate ID policy and practices training on April 13, 2013. He completed our internal training for restricted product sales occurred on April 26, 2013 (these verbal communications were documented and signed by him as part of our ongoing employee quality control and performance evaluation policies). Additionally, Christopher completed the Techniques of Alcohol Management Course provided by CHARR on May 7, 2013.

Our operating procedure requires all personnel to enter the DOB into the POS for verification of legal age, if the individual appears to be 30-years of age or younger. Christopher followed Tesoro procedure however, he input the incorrect year. When questioned about the incident Christopher stated that he "...misread the ID". He then had entered 1992 instead of 1995 into the POS. Christopher Glenn Jackson's employment was terminated following this incident.

I want to take this opportunity to respond to the Notice of Violation, 13-0535. As stated in the Notice, on December 23, 2013 former Brown Jug employee Faith Moeller did make a sale of alcoholic beverages to an underage person in violation of AS 04.16.052.

Ms. Moeller's conduct in this matter does not meet the professional standard of care we require our employees to exercise at Brown Jug. Accordingly, her employment was immediately terminated, she was trespassed from all Brown Jug locations, and a notice regarding the circumstances of her termination was posted on our internal website, all employees see this notice each time they clock in and out. We have made it very clear to all employees that the sale of alcohol to a minor will result in criminal prosecution, and immediate termination of employment.

At Brown Jug, we make every effort to prevent the sale of alcohol to minors. All store employees are required to attend a 'TAPS' alcohol server class before working in a store, and they are required by company policy to be in possession of the server card while at work. Since July of 1998, we have seized over 2400 ID cards from minors attempting to make a purchase at a Brown Jug location. Additionally since 2002, we have performed over 6300 in-house policy compliance tests on our employees to ensure that they are requesting ID from customers as required by company policy. Employees that fail to request ID from an in-house mystery shopper as required by company policy are immediately terminated. Each day when an employee reports for work, they sign a statement advising that they understand the policy regarding ID checks, and that they will follow the policy. Each time a transaction occurs on one of our registers, a pop up appears, reminding the employee that "Age Verification Is Required", displaying the "on or before" date of birth to legally make a sale. Additionally, any employee that successfully passes an ABC compliance test is eligible for a \$250 bonus.

- 3. **Review Corporate Policies** Print and review the OP-32 Sale of Tobacco Products and Paraphernalia Policy, OP-40 Sale of Alcohol Policy, Coaching Policy PD-30, and the Operational Compliance Accountability Matrix in the cashier meeting.

Reset Alcohol / Tobacco CBL – Computer Based Learning (CBL) module, that associate's must complete and pass again before selling alcohol / tobacco, should be reset at store level for all cashiers and managers of those cashier to retake the CBL after a violation.

Review Alcohol / **Tobacco Signing** – Ensure Corporate, State, and local (if applicable) required alcohol / tobacco signing is posted properly on the premises.

Review Other Documents – All required alcohol / tobacco training has been completed by associates and is documented by the Personnel Manager. This includes additional state or local training not covered by the CBL (where applicable) and additional employee acknowledgment forms, training certificates, or copies of cashier alcohol server licenses to sell alcohol (where applicable) are in a binder in the Personnel Office for inspection by law enforcement officials.

By way of introduction, this firm has been retained by Ms. Pak and the Seoul Gate Restaurant regarding the Notice of Violation received on March 7th in connection with a violation of AS 04.16.052 stemming from the sale of alcohol by Un Cha Munson, one of Ms. Pak's wait-staff. Because of Ms. Pak's limited English she has asked me to assist her in responding to the Notice.

Of particular frustration to Ms. Pak, and as reflected in her Affidavit as attached, is the fact that she has done everything within reason to avoid a violation of AS 04.16.052 by her wait-staff and additionally had implemented procedures at the Seoul Gate Restaurant that were focused on preventing the precise situation that occurred in this instance. Specifically, all Seoul Gate Restaurant wait-staff are mandated to timely complete the ABC Board's alcohol education course and all wait-staff have been issued a TAPS card. Additionally, in October 2013, Ms. Pak hired a Manager, Jina Yeom, who has also taken the TAPS training and who works diligently to supervise the wait-staff, including reinforcing with each of them on a weekly basis the ABC regulations regarding service of alcohol. In addition to being the only individual responsible for ordering and inventorying all alcohol products sold on site, every Monday morning Ms. Yeom meets with Seoul Gate's wait-staff to review duties and responsibilities for the upcoming week and to reemphasize alcohol procedures – the necessity of physically inspecting all ID's prior to any sale of alcohol in order to confirm the identity and DOB on the ID. Wait-staff are further instructed that if there is ever any question with regard to an ID they are to ask Jina for assistance since she is always on site.

Since receiving the Notice of Violation, both Ms. Pak and Jina Yeom have met individually with every Seoul Gate Restaurant employee to underscore the importance of checking every customer's ID and to emphasize the necessity of confirming each customer's date of birth. Further, the waitress who served the underage person, Un Cha Munson, has been instructed that she must repeat the ABC education course on the first day it is next offered

(April 14, 2014). Ms. Munson has also been told that should she fail to complete the alcohol education course and successfully reinstate her TAPS card her employment with Seoul Gate Restaurant will be terminated. Between now and the date that Ms. Munson completes the ABC course she will not be serving alcohol. What is particularly frustrating in this instance is that Ms. Munson is a three year employee who is well aware of the regulations and implications associated with serving alcohol to a minor.

It is noteworthy to mention that recently, on March 12th, Richard Finney, an investigator with the ABC Board visited the Seoul Gate Restaurant premises and conducted a site inspection to confirm compliance with ABC's posting requirements. Mr. Finney's inspection confirmed that the appropriate signage was posted regarding non-service to minors and that the year was accurately posted for the wait staff to readily ascertain whether a patron was of proper age to consume alcohol. Mr. Finney noted that the Seoul Gate Restaurant was in full compliance with ABC regulations.

Pursuant to 3AAC 304.525(B) Ms. Pak requests a teleconference with you, as Director, to be heard regarding this matter.

- I, Chong Pak, being first duly sworn, under oath, depose and state as follows:
- I am the owner and operator of Seoul Gate Restaurant in Fairbanks, Alaska.
 Seoul Gate Restaurant has a beverage dispensary license (No. 4941) issued
 by the State of Alaska, Alcoholic Beverage Board.
- On or about February 28, 2014 there was a violation of AS 04.16.052 by one of my wait staff, Un Cha Munson.
- 3. As owner of Seoul Gate, I require that all the wait staff take the ABC Board's education course and obtain a TAPS card. All of my wait staff have taken the ABC Board's educational class and carry the TAPS card. In addition, in October 2013, I hired Jina Yeom, as my Manager. Jina Yeom is solely responsible for the ordering and inventory of alcohol and for supervising the wait staff, including training the wait staff on compliance with ABC regulations regarding service of alcohol.
- 4. Every week, on Monday morning, the wait staff meet with Jina and myself to go over the duties and responsibilities for the week. At these meetings Jina also reemphasizes the need to verify every customer's ID and underscores the critical need to confirm the potential customer's date of birth with the date posted for that day. The staff are instructed that any questions regarding the

Affidavit of Chong Pak License No. 4941 No. AB14-0299 Page 1 of 3 validity of an ID presented by a patron, especially those unfamiliar out of state or military IDs, are to be discussed with Ms. Yeom before serving alcohol to a potentially underage person.

- 5. Since the February 28, 2014 violation, I have met with all of my wait staff to emphasize the critical importance of confirming each and every ID before serving alcohol and reiterated to my wait staff that service of alcohol to a minor is against the law and that failure to obtain proper ID and to confirm the legal age of each customer will not be tolerated.
- 6. In a conversation with Ms. Munson following the February 28, 2014 violation, my understanding of the incident as relayed by Ms. Munson is that she asked for identification from the patron before getting the requested alcohol beverage (beer) and upon bringing the beverage to the table, felt unsure and requested to see the identification again. The patron's ID was evidently a military spouse ID and the DOB was not clearly legible to Ms. Munson. Ms. Munson therefore placed the unopened beer and the ID on the table and asked the patron to wait while she got her eyeglasses. When Ms. Munson went to get her eyeglasses the kitchen flagged her down with hot food for another table, which she delivered before returning to the table where she was serving the beverage. When she got back to the table, the patron had opened the beer. Her decision to leave the unopened beverage on the table with the patron while she retrieved her eye glasses was inexcusable;

however, a patron at a neighboring table came forward and stated that he had heard Ms. Munson ask the young patron to wait for her to get her eyeglasses, and had witnessed the patron open the beer herself after Ms. Munson left. I can provide the Board with the name and telephone number of the witness if so requested.

To the Board Members of Alaska Liquor Control,

As the board meets in Anchorage and my business is in Juneau I am unable to attend physically but hope that this letter and attachments and my trying to make the telephone discussion on the Tuesday morning 29 th April helps you all make a clearer decision in the awarding of the one License.

Paradise Cafe has been in my possession for 11 years, 10 in downtown Juneau and now one and a half year in the "Valley". I am a sole proprietor and usually have a staff of about five. We service the community with a wonderful assortment of fresh homemade goods on a year round daily basis.

The first 10 years in the downtown location serving the community became less and less as the tourists took over the city and the bar scene bloomed everywhere. Having a forced move to my new valley location has given me the opportunity once again to be part of the community of people who live here year round and a great location for ferry and airport traffic of our outlying community members. I am very happy to have found this great location and developing a new clientele with many of our old group following and finding us again.

When the opportunity came available to make application for a beer and wine license I felt this location would serve the community well and not making, yet just another bar in the downtown core that already feels saturated. So we applied and have now waited more than two months, filled out all the forms and criteria that is required and waiting and planning without thought of asking about a list of what the Board looks for in granting the license.

Last week, a week away from the 29th decision date, I received an email from your office about the meeting and an invitation to come to Anchorage or conference call on a Tuesday at 10:50. I wanted very much to get a plane ticket and shut my business for the day if I felt you meeting me would help, but was then told the decision will be a draw from a hat, a flip of a coin.

I'm sure you might feel my dismay in this process. If this was a draw a lottery from the beginning and not an educated thoughtfully inspected process, why not have done this two months ago and not put two business through this rather unsettling ordeal?
