

A separate Beverage Dispensary License #2847 owned by John J. Lounsbury, d/b/a The Attic, was being operated at the same address in the upstairs area. On December 10, 2013, license #2847 transferred location and ownership, and the upstairs premises was vacated.

On December 31, 2013, an application for a Beverage Dispensary – Duplicate License for the upstairs by The Last Roundup, LLC was received, but an issue regarding right title and interest came to light. This issue was resolved on February 28, 2014, and the application was processed.

Because the upstairs premises at 2701 S Cushman Street has a separate fixed bar from the downstairs, and both spaces are leased by The Last Roundup, LLC, the applicant is requesting the Board to consider this application for a duplicate license as required under AS 04.11.090(e).


Dear Alcoholic Beverage Control Board,

The Voyager Restaurant was formerly known as the Corsair Restaurant. It was destroyed by flood in 2012, and has not been renovated or remodeled since the flood damage occurred.

In July, 2013, Hickel Investment Company (which owns and operates the Hotel Captain Cook) purchased the Voyager Hotel from RPS, LLC, which also owns the subject dispensary license.

The basement restaurant will probably never be re-opened as a food and beverage outlet due to the extensive flood damage sustained. On the other hand, Hickel investment Company plans to renovate the entrance at 944 West Fourth Avenue and connect it to the hotel lobby, which is currently served by an entrance on I Street. This change will include remodeling the lobby to also provide for limited food and beverage service for hotel guests. This is expected to be done within the next 18 months.

It is believed that this will qualify for an appropriate use of the tourism license, and that the Alcohol Beverage Control Board will approve the renovated premises for a transfer of the license to Hickel Investment Company dba the Voyager Hotel.

I still shake my head in disbelief that of all the servers, this action came from Brenda. She is normally composed and thorough, so her serving a minor stumps me. Regardless, she and I have discussed the error plus we have had meetings with all the servers to again review the house policies and state laws. Our Assistant Manager and I have been quizzing the servers on a regular basis to ensure they know the birth date of a 21 year old! I also posted a note which every server has signed after reading. The note includes:

"I need to make certain that everyone knows and understands the severity of serving alcohol to a minor. No excuse is acceptable!! Your job is to Ask for ID, read it with no uncertainty of the date, and then comprehend the date and be 100% certain that the person you will be serving is without a doubt over 21 years of age, or don't serve them at all! All of you have had the proper training and are capable servers, so there is no reason this should ever happen again! I thought that everyone was scared into full awareness after Kay made her mistake a year ago, please don't let this second error go without serving as a wake-up call to be more diligent to your duties in carding and serving only patrons of the proper age! This matter is of the utmost importance! Please take the time and pay attention! This can never happen again and I will be challenging each of you myself to ensure that it won't. You risk losing your job if you can't follow this simple policy."

I believe I have a very qualified and well trained staff who generally do an exemplary job of following the law, but this time Brenda failed to take the extra time necessary to process the information given her and made a gross error. She and I both apologize for the mistake and promise to try and ensure it won't happen again!

This letter is in response to Notice of Violation # AB14-0544 issued to our License #177 on 4/30/14 and received May 6th, 2014.

Investigator Hamilton states that he came in contact "with a female who was identified as the manager". As I told Investigator Hamilton verbally on 4/29/14, Shelly Shank was the individual he requested identification from, and she is in fact my Sales & Catering Manager here at the Breeze Inn. She was a patron of the business at the time of the encounter and was not on duty. When she returned to the lounge, Investigator Hamilton had left the premises, so she was unable to provide him with any of the identification he requested.

Ms. Shank was given additional duties effective April 10th which include oversight of the lounge. 3 AAC 304.465 states that "If the person cannot show a current card or a copy of it on file on the premises, or show a date of hire less than 30 days earlier, the person shall immediately cease selling or serving alcoholic beverages." As Ms. Shank had until May 10th under the law to attend and complete the requisite training, neither she nor the licensee were in violation. This letter is in response to the subject violation at Trail Lake Lodge on 23 Mar 2014. I have owned Trail Lake Lodge since 2007 and have made a concerted effort to educate and train my employees in their alcohol serving responsibilities to preclude any violations of the governing State statutes for the privilege of holding a liquor license. It is my responsibility and I accept the responsibility for this violation. When Ms Nichols first started working for me she had had lots of experience working at other food and beverage businesses. I made a bad assumption that she had a valid server card in her possession.

I am normally in the bar supervising operations in the winter time whenever the bar is open. Unfortunately, I was in Nevada and Minnesota from 21- 28 Mar on family business. It is our customary rule to check everyone's identification prior to being served. Ms Nichols stated to me that she did in fact look at the customer's military ID card (which she had never seen one before) and noticed the year on the ID was 1994 but for some reason she did not do the math in her head nor look at the three prominently posted cards that says "you must have been born on this date or prior in 1993 to be served". She learned a very valuable lesson in "focusing on what you are doing" from this event!

Ms Nichols has completed the server education course. Amy Fulton has provided her current and valid server card to Mr. Hamilton as she had provided an old card vice her current one.

In addition to Ms Nichols' recently completed formal server education, I have held remedial training at the start of each server's shift to remind them of the "date and year required to be served" and of the various types of ID cards that may be presented. Ms Nichols has volunteered to help train new staff that arrives for our summer season and to relay her own personal experience to our new personnel. I have personally checked all current servers' proof of server education cards and have a copy of them in my safe.

I will ensure that all new servers complete the server education prior to being assigned any server shift.

If you have any other recommendations for remedial training or for any other procedures or processes to preclude this from happening again I will certainly implement them! Sincerely,
