

RE: Director's Report

Licensing Section

The early renewal deadline of December 31, 2014 came and went and the agency is rapidly approaching the final renewal deadline of February 28, 2015. To date, 833 renewals have been received out of 904 renewals due. The licensing section has some temporary help from Candy Deutsch, who is a short term non-permanent employee. Candy started in January to assist the licensing section due to the amount of time the licensing supervisor, Sarah Oates, has had to dedicate to the marijuana initiative implementation.

Enforcement Section

The enforcement section has been working on inspections and compliance projects, including many "shoulder tap" investigations and a few complex investigations involving bottle clubs and keg parties. The enforcement officers conducted 63 inspections in Anchorage and Juneau and additional inspections in Fairbanks. They also conducted Title 4 training for two establishments in this reporting period. Chief Enforcement Officer Bob Beasley and Investigator Joe Bankowski attended bar security training at CHARR headquarters. Investigator Beasley reported that this training, which was conducted by Robert Smith of Nightclub Security Consultants from San Diego, California, was very valuable. He recommends that the training be added to the website as a recognized tool for the liquor industry.

Title 4 Review Work

The Title 4 revisions continue to be shepherded by the steering committee through the legislative process. Many members of the steering committee have made public presentations outlining various aspects of the suggested changes to Title 4. Chairman Klein has worked with CHARR membership to achieve consensus on the changes that most affect various tiers of the alcohol industry. The number of hours of work attributed to the effort has been revised from 6,000 to 7,000 hours in light of these additional meetings. The steering committee is optimistic that the revisions will be well-received by the legislature.





AS 17.38 Legislative Update

Work on implementation of AS 17.38 has continued to challenge the resources of the agency. I have testified or been available for questions at multiple committee meetings of the State Senate Affairs Committee, Joint Judiciary Committee, HHSS Committee, and House Community and Regional Affairs Committee, and listened to many other hearings. To date, only two bills relating to marijuana have been introduced (SB 30 and HB 59), but more are expected and the legislative process is time consuming and demanding on my time.

Alaska Municipal League Legislative Conference

On February 17 and 18, 2015, I will travel with Sarah Oates to Juneau for the Alaska Municipal League Legislative Conference. I will provide a presentation on marijuana for the AML and on the 18th the ABC will combine forces with two other DCCED agencies in manning a booth providing information for municipalities and local governments regarding the function and mission of the ABC board.







Tickett stated he went into 4Royal Parkers liquor store and bought a bottle of R & R Whiskey just before we showed up. SPD observed Tickett walk out of 4Royal Parkers upon their arrival. Tickett provided a partial sample for a PBT which of Tickett's pants. I spoke with four witnesses that had observed the altercation. The witnesses stated they observed Tickett and Washington stumbling down the sidewalk and observed an argument. They observed Tickett push Washington onto the ground. Tickett was arrested for Assault IV but was later found to have two prior Assault III.

Narrative:

On 6/27/14 at 1120 hours the Soldotna Public Safety Communication Center received a report of a possible assault in Soldotna. AST and Soldotna Police responded to the scene which was found to be approximately 1 1/2 mile of the Kenai Spur Highway in the 4Royal Parkers parking lot. Soldotna Police Officer Koenig arrived before me and was contacting a male and a female in the parking lot area near the sidewalk. The male and female were identified as **Rosaline Washington**, **AK6040164** and **Paul Tickett**, **AK6414555**. SPD observed Tickett walk out of 4Royal Parkers upon their arrival.

Washington and Tickett both showed signs of extreme intoxication and talking with them was difficult at times due to their extremely slurred speech. Both Washington and Tickett had blood shot watery eyes and a strong odor of alcohol. They staggered and swayed as they stood. I observed Washington to have fresh blood on her forehead from a scratch between her eyes running down toward her nose. Washington also had a scratch mark on her neck under her chin. Tickett was not cooperative and would walk away from me at times toward Washington. Tickett said nothing happened and he was only trying to buy food. Tickett said Washington was yelling at him. Tickett said he did not hold her down and he did not hurt her. Tickett said Washington was scratched by a branch and he did not "hurt his love". I placed Tickett in handcuffs and patted him down for safety. Inside the front waistband of his pants I found a bottle of R & R Whiskey that was unopened. I placed Tickett in the rear of my patrol vehicle to sort out what had occurred.

I attempted to speak to Washington who was uncooperative and continually walked away from me. Washington stated they had an argument and had walked from Nikiski and were trying to walk to Anchorage. Washington stated Tickett was her protector and nothing happened and she just wanted to leave. Washington stated the scratch was from a willow branch. Washington stated she was an alcoholic and later provided a partial sample for a PBT which showed a breath alcohol of .301%.

I called and spoke to one of the complainants by phone, **Heather Kohler, AK7250566**. Kohler stated she was driving on the Kenai Spur Highway and saw tow native people standing on the sidewalk and appeared to be in an argument. Kohler said she saw a female holding a bag, wearing a purple jacket. This description was consistent with Washington. Kohler stated she saw the two of them tussle and the male grabbed her by the throat while standing two the side of her. Kohler said she could see her face and it appeared she was distraught and she felt he was assaulting her so she called 911.

I requested Tickett provide PBT sample which he did not adequately do. I obtained a partial sample for a PBT which showed a breath alcohol of .267%.

I re-contacted Washington and asked her about being held by the throat and she stated nothing happened. Washington said Tickett was her protector. I tried to get information on a family member or someone that Washington could stay with. I was able to locate a phone number and spoke to a male who stated he knew the both of them but when they were intoxicated they were difficult to handle. The male said he did not want Washington to stay at his house. Washington's level of intoxication was very high and we could not find any place for her to go. Soldotna Police took Washington into protective custody and transported her to Central Peninsula Hospital. SPD provided the information for victims of domestic violence. Washington was then transported to Wildwood Pretrial Facility for a Title 47 hold.

I re-contacted Tickett and read him his Miranda Advisement. Tickett at first said he did not want to speak with me. Tickett then changed his mind and agreed to speak with me. Tickett said he would never hurt Washington and he never hit her. Tickett stated he went into 4Royal Parkers liquor store and bought a bottle of R & R Whiskey just before we showed up. I advised Tickett he was under arrest for Assault IV.

I went into 4Royal Parkers Liquor Store and observed the R & R Whiskey on the shelf. The whiskey had the same price tag as the bottle I found in Tickett's pants. The lot number on the back of the bottles on the shelf was the same as the bottle I had seized from Tickett. I spoke with Mr. Lee. Lee stated his wife had sold the bottle of whiskey to Tickett. Lee's wife, **Hee Hwan Lee, AK6286903**, told me that she sold the bottle to him and said she didn't know he was intoxicated or drunk. Hee Lee said he was not driving. I advised Lee I would contact them later for a charge of Selling to a Drunk Person. I confirmed the liquor license number of 4Royal Parkers was1295. Hee Lee's TAB card number was 84024.

I contacted **Harlene Bartlett, AK7310249**, and her husband, **Kevin Bartlett,AK7310512**, who were operating a burger trailer across the street from 4Royal Parkers. The Bartlett's stated they saw them walking down the sidewalk and she walked away from him and it looked like they got into a scuffle. They observed Tickett shove her to the ground and then picked her up and kissed her. Kevin stated he was going to go over there but Harlene did instead so Kevin and Tickett wouldn't get into an altercation. Harlene said she walked across the street and yelled at him to stop and Tickett told her he was protecting her.

I went to the hair salon across the street from 4Royal Parkers and spoke with **Jessica Phillips, AK7190026.** Phillips stated she came up front and saw the male shoving her toward the road and then the man walked into the liquor store. Phillips said she could tell they were both drunk. I also contacted **Jeffrey Willcox, AK7587365**, who stated he saw them walking down the sidewalk and they appeared falling down drunk and they were hugging. Willcox stated he saw the male push the female to the ground and yelling at her to watch his stuff. Willcox said it looked like he was trying to get money from her and out of her pockets. The female walked away from him but he would grab the bag she was holding and pull her back. The male grabbed her by the shoulders and she was trying to get away from him. The female threw something on the ground which Willcox believed to be money and the male picked it up and went into the liquor store.

During the arrest of Tickett he yelled multiple times at Washington in an attempt to speak with her. I advised him to not talk to her. Washington was taken to the hospital for medical clearance by SPD. Tickett was also taken to the hospital by Trooper Webber. Before going into the hospital Trooper Webber told Tickett to not speak with Washington. Upon entry into the hospital Tickett yelled "I love you" at Washington. He was then moved away where he couldn't see her any longer. Tickett was cleared at the hospital and remanded to Wildwood Pretrial Facility on a no bail status.

I later confirmed in APSIN that Tickett has two prior convictions for Assault IV under AS 11.41.230(a)(1). One conviction is on 07/14/08 and the second on 11/02/06. The convictions appear to be out of the Kotzebue Court.

On 6/28/14 I contacted Hee Lee at 4Royal Parkers and gave her a misdemeanor citation for Selling to a Drunk Person. It should be noted I put the wrong address for her and for the liquor store on the citation. I put the address as 36185 Sterling Highway and the correct address is 36185 Kenai Spur Highway.

I took photos of Washington although she did not cooperate with the photos. I also took photos of Tickett and photos of the liqour bottles in 4Royal Parkers. I also took photos of the liqour bottle that I seized that matched the lot number from 4 Royal Parkers. The photos were placed on the AST photo server. My audio contact with all parties were placed into AST evidence.

On 6/27/2014 at approx. 1215 hours I met with Sgt. Fowler in the parking lot of Four Royle Parkers per his request. Sgt. Fowler had arrested **Paul Tickett, AK6414555**, for (DV) Assault IV and Intoxicated on a Licensed Premise and requested that I transport him Wildwood Pre-Trial. I noted P. Tickett appeared highly intoxicated as displayed by his watery bloodshot eyes, slurred speech and the odor of alcohol that was on his breath and person. I was advised that his PBT sample had been .267 BrAC.

I moved him from Sgt. Fowler's patrol vehicle to my own and transported P. Tickett to Central Peninsula Hospital (CPH) for a medical evaluation prior to remand due to his high level of intoxication. I knew that P. Tickett's girlfriend (**Rosaline Washington**, **AK6040164**) who was the victim of his assault had also been transported to CPH for a medical evaluation due to intoxication.

Upon our arrival at CPH I warned P. Tickett that he would be charged with an additional criminal charge of if he attempted to communicate or talk with his girlfriend. P. Tickett, who was handcuffed and sitting on the rear seat of my patrol vehicle, told me in a slurred voice that he wasn't even in trouble. I informed him that he was under arrest and escorted him into the Emergency Room at CPH. I informed the ER staff that P. Tickett could not communicate with his girlfriend.

One of the hospital staff met us and began escorting us from the waiting room to a treatment room. While walking through the ER I was able to see R. Washington laying on a gurney in a treatment room approx. 20 feet from us. P. Ticket looked at the room and yelled, "I love you!" to which R. Washington responded that she loved him too. I advised him to be quiet and to not speak to R. Washington and we walked to a different treatment room, out of sight of R. Washington. I informed Sgt. Fowler of the contact between P. Tickett and R. Washington.

After an extended wait P. Tickett was seen by one of the ER's attending physicians. During the examination he admitted to drinking alcohol and taking an oxycodone pill earlier. He medically cleared P. Tickett and we left the hospital.

I transported P. Tickett to Wildwood Pre-Trial and remanded him there without further incident. This concludes my involvement in the incident.

OBSERVATION:

On 1-17-14, at about 2011 hours, Underage Buyer 13-012; age 18, herein referred to as UB, entered Circle M Bar. I remained outside. At about 2015 hours, UB sent me a text message essentially relating she had been furnished, later learned sold, a Corona beer. Age was not asked but ID was asked for. The ID presented was a valid military dependent card which has the date of birth on the back of the card in the upper left corner. It reads, "1995AUG16".

OFFICER ACTION:

At about 2019 hours, I entered the establishment and located UB seated at the bar with an opened bottled Corona beer in front of her. I took a photo of UB seated with the beer. I introduced myself to the bartender, who UB identified as her server. UB provided me her ID card and departed the establishment. The bartender was identified as Elizabeth M. Bellmay. Contact was also made with Cassandra E. Powell, who identified herself as the owner. I later checked the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC) files and learned she is a licensee of more than 30 days.

INTERVIEW #1, SI, E.M. BELLMAY:

Conducted in a non-custodial manner. Bellmay repeatedly stated UB's ID said 95. I advised her she was right. Bellmay then looked at UB's ID card again and stated that was not the ID UB showed her; she could read it without putting on her glasses. I asked her how she got UB's birth year right to which she replied the ID said "95". I then advised Bellmay UB was only 18. Bellmay asked the owner if 95 was good to be servered and the owner, Powell, said it was. Bellmay recalls serving UB a Corona beer. Bellmay said something just didn't click, she asked for ID because UB didn't look 18 or 30. Bellmay has been serving alcoholic beverages for 10-15 years and has received alcohol server training, TAP card which expires 11-5-16, instructor HRK.

INTERVIEW #2, SI, C.E. POWELL:

Conducted in a non-custodial manner. During my conversation with Bellmay, she kept saying to Powell, that she said 95. Powell would reply by saying I thought you said 85. Powell started a conversation with UB and advised UB she had a daughter about UB's age. She stated she also asked UB if she was 28 to which UB said, "Yeah". While talking to me, Powell stated she heard "84" and then started a conversation with UB about her daughter being the same age. When asked to provide proof of server education, she stated she was just stopping by and did not have her server card.

OFFICER ACTION:

I later checked with Alaska Cabaret, Hotel, Restaurant & Retailer's Association and learned that Powell does have current server education. Powell was advised she needed to have her server education card when conducting business on the premises. I then advised them of what was going to happen regarding charges against Bellmay. I then departed the establishment.

NOTE:

UB completed 11 compliance checks on 1-17-14. Two establishments sold an alcoholic beverage. UB also advised me that when Bellmay asked Powell about her birth year, Powell replied she wasn't good at that stuff and said UB was 28 years old.

EVIDENCE:

Digital audio and photos. The beer was left at the establishment.

CASE STATUS:

Closed. A charge of furnishing alcohol to a person under 21 and allowing an under 21 person to enter and remain are being referred to the DAO for Bellmay. Complainant states that on or about the 17th of January, 2014, at or near North Pole in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, Cassandra Elaine Powell, a licensee or an agent or an employee of the licensee with criminal negligence allowed another person to sell, give, or barter an alcoholic beverage to a person under the age of 21 years within licensed premises.

All of which is a class A misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of A.S. 04.16.052(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

CTN 002 LICENSEE RESPONSIBLE FOR VIOLATIONS A.S. 04.16.150

Complainant states that on or about the 17th of January, 2014, at or near North Pole in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, Cassandra Elaine Powell,

Did either knowingly allow agents or employees to violate this title or regulation adopted under this title nor recklessly or with criminal negligence fail to act in accordance with the duty prescribed under AS 04.21.030 with the result that an agent or employee of this licensee violates a law or regulation.

All of which is a class A misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of A.S. 04.16.150 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

This complaint is based upon the statement of Underage Buyer 13-012; age 18, herein referred to as UB. UB was conducting an alcohol compliance check at the Defendant's establishment, Circle M Bar, a licensed liquor establishment in or near North Pole. The Defendant is a licensee of that establishment. The on-duty bartender asked the Defendant if UB, born in 1995, was old enough to be served. The Defendant's replied she wasn't good with that stuff, but approved the sale. The bartender sold UB a bottled Corona beer, an alcoholic beverage and allowed the underage person to remain on the licensed premises. The Defendant, a licensee of more than 30 days, was asked to provide proof of server education. She stated she does have it but could not provide proof. Finally, UB was a person whose age was verified by Investigator F.R. Hamilton, Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, prior to the furnishing and UB was working as an undercover operative for the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.






