A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH PLANNING COMMISSION ADOPTING FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW TO SUPPORT DENIAL OF PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION 15-04.

WHEREAS, Planning Commission Resolution 15-04 was for approval of a conditional use permit for the operation of an alcoholic beverage dispensary (bar) at the 907 Club, located within Township 17 North, Range 3 West, Section 21; Tax ID# 5428000T00A, Seward Meridian; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2015, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on Resolution 15-04; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission failed to garner a majority vote on February 2, 2015 which constitutes denial of the conditional use permit; and

WHEREAS, comments received regarding the proposed alcoholic beverage dispensary (bar) raised the following concerns:

- Noise would change the character of the neighborhood/area
- Inability to mitigate noise impacts due to close proximity to residential neighborhoods
- Hours of operations (open until 5:00AM) would negatively impact neighbors
- Use is not compatible with character of area
- Use would negatively impact a State campground 700-feet from proposed conditional use
- Parking lot run-off would impact the lake waters
- Light pollution

- Concerns for bike path/ATV traffic and potential intoxicated driver from bar
- More potential drunk drivers on the road system
- Potential increase of alcohol related incidents and crimes
- General traffic increase to the area
- Vagueness / Incomplete application material
- Will have same negative impact to neighbors as "Fish Heads Bar"
- Property Value will decrease due to noise pollution
- No local police to help mitigate alcohol related incidents
- Concerns of non-compliance by the applicant, due to violation of other CUP and lack of willingness to "follow the rules"

WHEREAS, Goal LU-1 of the Borough-Wide Comprehensive Plan (2005 Update) is to Protect and enhance the public safety, health, and welfare of Borough residents; and

WHEREAS, Policy LU1-1 Borough-Wide Comprehensive Plan (2005 Update) is to Provide for consistent, compatible, effective, and efficient development within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Goal LU-2 of the Borough-Wide Comprehensive Plan (2005 Update) is to Protect residential neighborhoods and associated property values; and

WHEREAS, Policy LU2-1 of the Borough-Wide Comprehensive Plan (2005 Update) is to Develop and implement regulations that protect residential development by separating incompatible uses, while encouraging uses that support such residential uses including office, commercial and other mixed-use developments that are shown to have positive cumulative impacts to the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Goal LU-3 of the Borough-Wide Comprehensive Plan (2005 Update) is to Encourage commercial and industrial development that is compatible with residential development and local community desires; and

WHEREAS, Policy LU3-1 of the Borough-Wide Comprehensive Plan (2005 Update) is to Develop and implement regulations that provide for non-residential development; and

WHEREAS, the developed properties along South Big Lake Road are predominantly commercial, but produce little to no amplified noise; and

WHEREAS, the nearest operating alcoholic beverage dispensary in the Big Lake area is Floaters on Big Lake Road, about one quarter mile from this site; and

WHEREAS, the subject parcel was originally Lots 2, 3, & 4, of Block 1 of the "Rocky Big Lake Subdivision"; and

WHEREAS, Rocky Lake Subdivision abuts the proposed conditional use; and

WHEREAS, the character of the Rocky Lake Area is known to be of a quiet and family-friendly atmosphere; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Administrative Code 11 AAC 20.922 - Use of Power Boats at Rocky Lake State Recreation Site, prohibits the use of jet skis, jet boats with inboard motors, and airboats; and

WHEREAS, Rocky Lake State Recreation Site is less than 600-

feet from the proposed conditional use; and

WHEREAS, Rocky Lake State Recreation Site has quiet hours of 10:00PM to 6:00AM; and

WHEREAS, the application material shows a 2,496-square foot bar with a 150-square foot smoking deck/beer garden; and

WHEREAS, the application material shows a 1,400-square foot "bandstand" (outdoor music stage); and

WHEREAS, the applicant indicated he was unsure of the hours of operation for the bar portion of the business, but that he could operate 21-hours a day, from 8:00AM to 5:00AM the following day; and

WHEREAS, the applicant indicated he was unsure of the hours of operation for the restaurant portion of the business, but that he could operate 23-hours a day, from 6:00AM to 5:00AM the following day; and

WHEREAS, the applicant provided little to no detail on the operation of the bandstand, such as hours of operation, number of expected attendees, parking and traffic impacts, and noise generated by the use; and

WHEREAS, the applicant did not address the noise impact to the community or adjacent neighborhood that the bar and bandstand would create; and

WHEREAS, the nearest developed residential lot is approximately 35-feet from the subject parcel; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has provided conflicting information in the application material as to noise mitigation measures. On page 2, question #6, the applicant states a berm will be installed with newly planted trees to mitigate noise, dust and traffic. The site plan shows an 8-foot tall wooden fence will be installed; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has provided conflicting information in the application material as to noise mitigation measures. On page 2, question #4, of the application, the applicant states that state of the art noise buffering material will be installed. In an email, dated January 14, 2015, the applicant states he is undecided on the installation of noise buffering material in the bar structure; and

WHEREAS, MSB 8.52.010(A) declares: "The borough hereby finds and declares that noise, volume-enhanced sounds and their concomitant vibration are significant sources of environmental pollution which represent a present and increasing threat to public peace and to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the borough. Loud noise and amplified sounds have

an adverse effect on the psychological and physiological wellbeing of persons."; and

WHEREAS, according to Rutgers Noise Technical Assistance
Center, music concerts typically produce sound greater than 100decibles (db), which falls in the "deafening" category; and

WHEREAS, according to Rutgers Noise Technical Assistance
Center, a quiet to noisy home produces sound around 30-60db,
which falls in the "faint" and "moderate" categories; and

WHEREAS, production of sound levels, such as 100-db adjacent to a quiet neighborhood would have an adverse impact to its residents; and

WHEREAS, without factual details of the proposed bar and bandstand, an accurate assessment of the impact to the community and adjacent neighborhood cannot be made; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is 4.96-acres in size. The proposed conditional use will occupy approximately 1.85-acres on the east side of the property, which accesses South Rosalie Court; and

WHEREAS, a Matanuska-Susitna Borough driveway permit is required but has not been obtained for access onto South Rosalie Court; and

WHEREAS, the adjacent properties to the back (north and northwest) side of this lot are developed with residential homes; and

WHEREAS, the application material shows a proposed "illuminated sign on pole" with no other details such as, size, type of illumination, or glare impact; and

WHEREAS, the application material shows 11 wall mounted lights on the exterior of the building. No details such as, size, type of illumination, or glare impact was provided in the application material; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Planning Commission hereby adopts the aforementioned findings of fact and makes the following conclusions of law supporting denial of Planning Commission Resolution 15-04:

- the commission finds this conditional use is not compatible with, will not preserve, and will materially detract from the value, character and integrity of the surrounding area (MSB 17.70.100(A)(1)(a)); and
- 2. the commission concludes this conditional use, as proposed, will be harmful to the public health, safety, convenience and welfare (MSB 17.70.100(A)(1)(b))); and

- the commission finds sufficient setbacks, lot area, buffers or other safeguards have not been provided (MSB 17.70.100(A)(1)(c)); and
- 4. the commission finds there will be negative effects upon the properties in the area due to such factors as noise, obtrusive advertising and glare (MSB 17.70.100(A)(2)(a)); and
- 5. the commission finds measures are not in place to reduce any negative effect upon adjacent and nearby properties (MSB 17.70.100(A)(2)(c)); and
- 6. the commission concludes the proposed conditional use is not compatible with the character of the surrounding neighborhood (MSB 17.70.100(A)(2)(g)); and
- the proposed conditional use, as proposed, is inconsistent with the goals and policies of the Borough-Wide Comprehensive Plan (2005 Update).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this is a final determination which may be appealed in accordance with MSB 15.39.140 by filing a written notice of appeal with the Borough Clerk within 21 days from the date this determination was issued. If an appeal is not filed as described in the preceding sentence, the right to appeal is forfeited.

WHEREAS, T&M Enterprises, Inc. has made application with the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board and has paid the required fee for renewal of Package Store Liquor License #3556 for Spirits of Alaska, located at 1149 Gambell Street, Anchorage, Alaska (Exhibit A);

WHEREAS, standards governing Assembly protests to the ABC Board in AMC 2.30.125 and 3 AAC 304.180 include:

- Land use consideration Is there a permanent negative impact greater than that anticipated from permitted development on pedestrian and vehicular traffic circulation and safety; the demand for and availability of public services and facilities; noise, air, water or other forms of environmental pollution; maintenance of compatible and efficient development patterns and land use intensities?
- Training Does the applicant demonstrate prospective compliance with a program for techniques in alcohol management (T.A.M.)?
- Operations procedures Does the applicant demonstrate prospective compliance with operations procedures for licensed premises described in AMC 10.50.035?
- Public safety considerations -- Does the applicant demonstrate the ability to maintain order and prevent unlawful conduct in licensed premises, including any adjacent area under the control or management of the licensee?
- Public health Has the operator engaged in a pattern of practices injurious to public health or safety or other actions within the knowledge and control of the operator which place the public health or safety at risk?

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code and state law provide the Anchorage Assembly the opportunity to protest a license renewal upon facts that render the particular

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application objectionable to the local governing body, or may be based upon a general public policy with a reasonable basis in fact, not contrary to law, and not patently inapplicable to the particular application;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has faced increasing public safety challenges in the Fairview community related to chronic inebriates;

WHEREAS, T&M Enterprises, Inc. dba Spirits of Alaska located at 1149 Gambell Street has been in operation as a package liquor store since 1995. In 1995, the Anchorage Assembly took special measures to accomplish package liquor store compatibility with the local community. (Exhibit B);

WHEREAS, in the 1995 approval, public safety considerations were addressed by onsite surveillance cameras; provision for security staff to monitor the area, and T.A.M. training for all employees (Exhibit B);

WHEREAS, licensee implementation of these public safety, use, and mitigation considerations proved insufficient for public health and safety and at least three (3) ABC Board Notices of Violation were issued against the licensed premises at this location between 2009 and 2012 (Exhibit C).

WHEREAS, since March 2014 the Fairview Community Council has attempted to work collaboratively with Bridget Thompson owner of T&M Enterprises, Inc. dba Spirits of Alaska and the Anchorage Police Department to develop and implement an action plan to reduce loitering of chronic inebriates and associated undesirable behaviors that negatively impact the livelihoods of nearby property owners and the quality of life of other users of the public space (Exhibit D) & (Exhibit G);

WHEREAS, on February 12, 2015 the Fairview Community Council voted to oppose continuation of the conditional use permit associated with this premises and asked the Assembly to rescind the conditional use permit currently in place and to protest renewal of the liquor license for this establishment (Exhibit D);

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Assembly and Municipal Clerk's Office has received written comments from individuals and entities concerning the renewal of package store liquor licenses #3556 (Exhibit E);

WHEREAS, the Municipal Clerk reports there are taxes owing to the Municipality of Anchorage in the amount of \$2083.58 (Exhibit F);

WHEREAS, public hearing on the exercise or waiver of protest has been duly scheduled for April 14, 2015[March 24, 2015];

WHEREAS, the proposed findings in Section 1 of this Assembly Resolution state the reasons for the protest and a copy of this Assembly Resolution and the accompanying Assembly Memorandum of Exhibits have been provided to the applicants and representatives by no later than 21 days in advance of public hearing on April 14, 2015[March 24, 2015];

WHEREAS, on <u>April 14, 2015[March 24, 2015]</u>, the Assembly having reviewed the standards for protest and the exhibits, held public hearing, reviewed and deliberated the proposed findings in support of protest;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY hereby enters its protest regarding the renewal of package store liquor license #3556; and further resolves:


<u>Section 1</u>: The Anchorage Assembly makes the following findings in support of the protest. Each finding, taken alone, is considered by the Anchorage Assembly as independent grounds for protest:

- Finding 1. Historical experience with this location and with one or more other locations, demonstrates to the Anchorage Assembly as a matter of general public policy, there is a permanent negative impact greater than that anticipated from permitted development, on a) pedestrian and vehicular traffic circulation and safety; b) the demand for and availability of public services and facilities; and c) noise and public litter, when the licensed premises is operated under an operating plan such as the one currently utilized by T&M Enterprises, Inc.
- Finding 2. Written comments (Exhibit E) and surveillance images (Exhibit G) taken together with Alcoholic Beverage Control Board Notices of Violations (Exhibit C) is insufficient to demonstrate prospective compliance with alcohol management training and requisite operational procedures.
- Finding 3. The current operating plan utilized by T&M Enterprises, Inc. is insufficient to overcome concerns by the Anchorage Assembly about the ability of T&M Enterprises, Inc. to demonstrate the trustworthiness and fitness to responsibly conduct a licensed package liquor store without potential harm to the public interest in areas of a) alcohol management training in light of written comment (Exhibit E) and b) record keeping and financial management practices (Exhibits F).
- A copy of this Assembly Resolution may be presented to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board as proof that the Anchorage Assembly, as the local governing body, has stated its protest after public hearing on April 14, 2015[March 24, 2015[March 24, 2

Dear Chairman Klein:

This letter is provided as an objection to the Municipality of Anchorage's ("MOA") Resolution AR 2015-067 that protests renewal of License No. 3556. T & M Enterprises, Inc. ("Licensee") was informed Friday afternoon, April 23, 2015, that it had an opportunity to submit something in writing as long as it was provided before 8:00 am on Monday, April 27, 2015. In light of the shortness of time, this response will be brief, and will likely be supplemented during your Board hearing to be held on April 29, 2015. Licensee appreciates the opportunity to briefly set out the objections to the protest and request that the license be renewed despite the protest because the MOA's decision is arbitrary and capricious.

Licensee has operated under this liquor license since 1994, and conducted business at the above location since 1995. When it moved into this current location, it entered into the most comprehensive conditions of any conditional use permit approved by the

Municipality of Anchorage. In the almost 20-years of operating under that use permit, Licensee has never received notice of violation of any of the conditions of the conditional use permit. Additionally, there has never been a finding of a violation of any of the conditions of the conditional use permit. This conditional use permit is a matter of public record and a copy is attached for your convenience.

The file maintained by the Board on License No. 3556 demonstrates that Licensee has had a total four (4) notices of violations issued during nearly 20-years of operation. One notice was issued in 2009 for furnishing liquor to an underage person and for allegedly not having the proper signs posted. Licensee promptly investigated both claims, and upon a review of the facts and circumstances surrounding the sales allegation, the individual followed proper procedure and checked the identification, but made the choice to sell to a "fellow military person." That individual was immediately terminated. Licensee disputed the sign posting issue and pointed out that the one set of required signs were posted in their correct dimensions, and an additional set of signs had been trimmed.

Licensee also received one (1) notice of violation in 2010 for a sale to an inebriated person. Licensee reviewed the tape with the clerk, and although it was not clear form the tape if the individual was visibly intoxicated, the clerk decided to take responsibility for this event, accepted a one year suspended imposition of sentence, complied with all conditions of probation and has since had the conviction set aside.

Licensee received two (2) notices of violations in 2012 - the first in January 2012, and the second in May of 2012. Both of these violations were for furnishing liquor to an underage person and for allegedly not having the proper signs posted. Licensee promptly investigated both claims, and upon a review of the facts and circumstances surrounding these sales, including a review of the tapes and both of the clerks were terminated. The Board chose to not take formal action against the licensee under the provisions of AS 44.62.330-AS 44.62.630. No notices of violation have been issued in the last three (3) years of operation and licensee has passed each and every random compliance check made by the Board.

In spite of the fact that Licensee has taken appropriate action each and every time a notice of violation was issued, and in spite of the fact that Licensee has had no violations of the conditional use permit, the MOA ultimately decided to protest renewal of the license. Licensee believes that, unbeknownst to Licensee, the decision to protest renewal began in late 2013 or early 2014 when the Fairview Community Council ("FVCC") was preparing to submit a proposal to the Anchorage Assembly to have a 65-block area known as the Fairview Business District designated as a "deteriorated

area" thus making the area eligible for revitalization tax breaks and other opportunities allowed under Anchorage's revitalization program. In fact, in July 2014, Assembly Member, Patrick Flynn, who represents the Fairview area, was successful in securing a "deteriorated area" designation on behalf of the FVCC.

Beginning in late 2013, early 2014, Licensee and The Oaken Keg Spirit Shop located approximately one block from Licensee began a dialogue with the FVCC regarding the Council's concerns with the operation of both stores in the neighborhood. Several meetings were held with the FVCC and its public safety committee. The parties were in active discussion to revisit and perhaps revise/update the "conditions" of each store's conditional use permits. Licensee's conditional use permit was and remains by far the most restrictive. During the initial meeting with FVCC, Licensee was shown a video clip allegedly depicting inebriated individuals to the far north side of Licensee's building. There was no indication or suggestion that these two individuals where sold alcohol by Sprits of Alaska. In fact, the white plastic bag they were holding makes clear they did not purchase anything from Sprits of Alaska as it contained an orange juice bottle not sold by Licensee.

Contrary to the representations later reflected in an exhibit submitted to the Anchorage Assembly in support of the current protect (See Exhibit G), these two individuals were NOT outside the front doors of Sprits of Alaska; rather, they were located on the north of the entrance of the store just north of the doors to the vacant space. It was not clear if the Community Action Policing ("CAPS") officer called CPS to come render aid, or if they merely video-taped the event to later be used as evidence. Because this was shown to the Licensee much later in time, with no specific date and time indicated, it was impossible to pull the store tapes to see if they even entered and were denied service, or to pull the written log required to be kept under its conditional use permit to see if CPS was called by staff. This video clip was taken before the store installed video surveillance facing that direction. Additional clips were shown of the front and side south side of Licensee's building allegedly showing a clerk who was fired prior to having been shown the video, and patrons who had been permanently trespassed. What was clearly shown was individuals on the south side of the building loitering, and it was in a blind spot in Licensee's camera system.

Ultimately, Licensee and Oaken Keg were asked to do ceratin things. Licensee agreed to upgrade and add security cameras at locations to be suggested by Officer Jones of the Anchorage Police Department, CAPS team. Licensee was also asked to add lighting to the south side of the building. Licensee complied with all requests. The details of the discussion relating the scope of the proposed conditions will be discussed with the Board, but in the end there were only two things that Licensee could not agree

to: (1) hiring a \$70,000.00 a year security guard, and (2) honoring a "trespass" or "no sale list." Licensee has, however, a designated night person as their security person, and simply cannot afford to hire another. Regarding the "no sale list," Licensee did not refuse to follow such a list. Instead, based on experience gained from being an Attorney who worked for the Anchorage Equal Rights Commission, Licensee simply ask if such a list would be legal. Licensee wanted to know if the Municipal Attorney would sign off on the list. Licensee was rightly concerned about a list complied that may, in all likelihood would be dominated by a certain race or ethnic group and which might result in complaints of racial discrimination or racial profiling. In light of that concern, Licensee simply ask the FVCC if the Municipal attorney would sign off on the list so the MOA or the FVCC could defend Licensee if racial complaints were made against it. Licensee also made clear that such a list is already created by the State and that Licensee complied with Red Strip law which prohibits those who have a red strip on their identification as ordered by a court after a due process hearing.

After a public hearing on March 24, 2015, the Anchorage Assembly made the following findings in support of the MOA's protest:

Historical experience with this location and with one or more other locations, demonstrates to the Anchorage Assembly as a matter of general public policy, there is a permanent negative impact greater than that anticipated from permitted development, on a) pedestrian and vehicular traffic circulation and safety; b) the demand for and availability of public services and facilities; and c) noise and public litter, when the licensed premises is operated under an operating plan such as the one currently utilized by T&M Enterprises, Inc.

Finding 2. Written comments (Exhibit E) and surveillance images (Exhibit G) taken together with Alcoholic Beverage Control Board Notices of Violations (Exhibit C) is insufficient to demonstrate prospective compliance with alcohol management training and requisite operational procedures.

Finding 3. The current operating plan utilized by T&M Enterprises, Inc. is insufficient to overcome concerns by the Anchorage Assembly about the ability of T&M Enterprises, Inc. to demonstrate the trustworthiness and fitness to responsibly conduct a licensed package liquor store without potential harm to the public interest in areas of a) alcohol management training in light of written comment (Exhibit E) and b) record keeping and financial management practices (Exhibits F).

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Licensee submits that the MOA's decision was arbitrary and capricious because Licensee was denied a fair and impartial hearing before the Anchorage Assembly. See Public Safety Employees Ass'n v. Alaska 902 P 2d 1334 (Alaska 1995). As this case instructs, a decision is arbitrary and capricious if the decision was rendered without consideration of mandated provisions or if the decision was made on unreasonable grounds or without any proper consideration of current circumstances.

AS 04.11.480 provides that a local governing body may protest, among other actions, a liquor license renewal application. Pursuant to this enabling legislation, the ABC Board has adopted regulations among them 3 AAC 304.145 and 150. Under 3 AAC 304.145(d), it is required that "a local governing body that protests an application shall allow a reasonable opportunity to defend the application before a meeting of the local governing body". The statute and regulations do not specifically define what process must be afforded an applicant, only that there must be that "reasonable opportunity to defend". However, the MOA, through the adoption of its own ordinances, has established certain rights for an applicant to be able to be afforded that meaningful "due process" opportunity to defend it application. Chief among them is the right to have an opportunity to engage in a ex parte communication with the assembly members, clearly adopted in recognition of the importance of the property right at stake in any renewal process. MCA §2.30120(H). However, contrary to the mandate that an applicant be afforded that reasonable opportunity to defend as required by 3 AAC 304.145(d), and specifically defined by the MOA under its governing ordinances, Licensee was specifically denied its "meaningful opportunity to defend". An email was sent from the MOA Attorney Dennis Wheeler to the entire Assembly which indicated that they were prohibited from having any "ex parte communications" with Licensee, contrary to the clear right so engage. However, an Article in the Alaska Dispatch News dated March 2, 2015 makes clear that the FVCC had ex parte communication with Assembly members.

Members of he Assembly would not talk to or meet with Licensee and there was no ability to engage in any ex parte communication as allowed under MCA §2.30.120(H). Refusing to allow an applicant to participate in the opportunity to defend it's application in a manner allowed by the local governing body's own established local laws is a clear demonstration that the ultimate decision made by the local governing body was in violation of due process and was in violation of 3AAC 304.145(d). Even one Assembly member, Assemblyman Evans, stated that the process used to consider this protest did not comply with the process used in past protest actions. Any "protest" that denies an applicant the meaningful opportunity to defend, as required by law and regulation is necessarily arbitrary, capricious and unreasonable. As indicated by

<u>Public Safety Employees Ass'n v. Alaska</u> 902 P 2d 1334 (Alaska 1995) a single failure to follow the law or process can support an arbitrary and capricious finding.

Not only did the MOA deny certain rights to Licensee, it considered information that was irrelevant to Licensee's business practices and that are completely beyond the control of Licensee and this Board. Exhibit G relied on by the MOA clearly blames Licensee for the crimes committed in the neighborhood, that are committed in areas where Licensee has no authority or control. They apparently even blame the Licensee for calls of intoxicated drivers on Gambell Street, individuals driving on a suspended license, assaults, and other crimes that were not committed on the Licensee's premises. The FVCC and the MOA clearly relied on circumstances that were not within the control of Licensee and therefore the MOA's decision was arbitrary and capricious as a matter of law.

In closing, Licensee requests that the ABC Board look closing at the underpinnings of the MOA protest decision. Licensee is confident that close scrutiny of the exhibits and evidence relied on by the MOA will show that there are no allegations of unlawful conduct on the part of Licensee and the overwhelming majority of the conduct and problems experienced by the local community are outside the ability of Licensee to manage and correct. The Licensee will not have its employees break up drug deals in Fairview or assaults in Fairview, as that is dangerous and irresponsible and should be left to the professionals, the police. It is clearly arbitrary to single out this location, and not look to both package stores in Fairview that are within one block of each other. Although APD has video of Oaken Keg, it never provided that the Licensee or the Assembly with such video to serve as a point of comparison or contrast, nor did it compare "police calls" within 100 feet of Carr's property. There is no causal connection established between any such calls and the operations of the Licensee, the two years APD looked to actually demonstrate a significant drop (26%) in such calls, and it is arbitrary and unreasonable to attribute such calls to the management and operational procedures of the Licensee. Each time Licensee has had a problem within its jurisdiction, it has taken immediate corrective action. Licensee does not have the jurisdiction or ability to correct community wide problems and therefore should not be deprived of a valuable property right based on circumstances that are not within the boundaries of its licensed premises.






