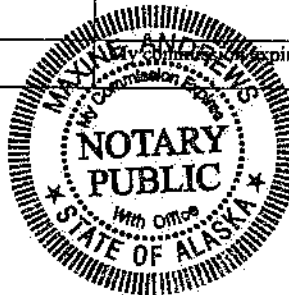

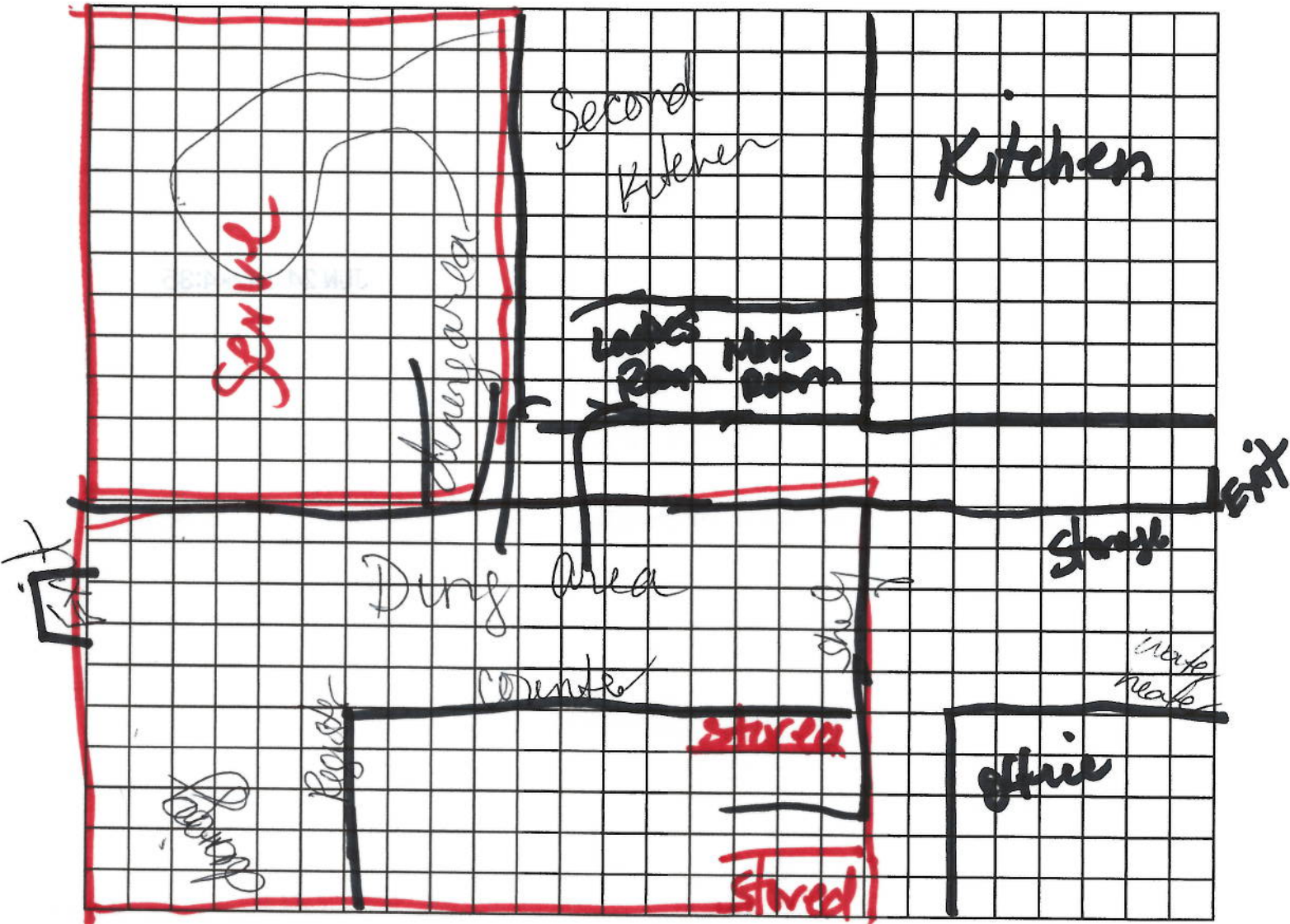

To whom it may concern,

The reason for this letter is to provide a thorough explanation for my felony convictions.

When I was 14 I was in a terrible car accident and was badly injured. I was given pain medication for the pain but did not like the way it made me feel. I visited a physical therapist for a short time after but my insurance only allowed me to keep that up for so long. I suffered from neck and back pain for years and not being treated only made the injuries worse. When I was 31 I was in for a routine checkup and mentioned the pain to my doctor, he prescribed me pain medicine to help. While the feeling I hated when I was younger had become a different story, the medicine seemed to dull any physical or emotional pain I was feeling at the time. Eventually I became physically and mentally addicted to the medicine. After a couple of years my doctor recognized my addiction and by this time were prescribing a very strong narcotic Oxycontin and a lot of it. He said he was having similar problems with other patients and wouldn't be prescribing it to anyone anymore. I realized that if I stopped taking it I became violently ill and suffered from severe withdrawal. I sought help by entering myself into a treatment facility in Juneau where they detoxed me with liquid methadone which they gave me up until 3 days before my release date. They released me to another patient there that had graduated two weeks before me. She picked me up in a cab and went straight to the pharmacy to pick up oxycontin. The woman was an IV drug user and had convinced me it was a much more sufficient way to use the drug. When she picked me up I was under the impression that she was sober, as it was not my intention to use again. I later found out the treatment center I had checked myself into did not have a license to use methadone to detox its patients, as it is not a good idea. Methadone takes a long time to detox off of itself. A few days later I flew home. I was worse off than I was when I left. I went back to my doctor who then gave me Hydrocodone. The woman I met from Juneau had also come to anchorage and contacted me. We spent the first evening taking our kids to the movies and she told me her intentions were good, but we were both in no shape to be around each other trying to help each other. The next time we came in contact with each other my life drastically changed for the worst and went downhill. She took me to another IV drug user's house where I tried heroin and cocaine for the first time. I met a lot of undesirable people and within a year had become just like them. Completely addicted and feeling worthless and missing my children. I started getting arrested for stupid things which eventually led me to my felony charge. The charge was mics 3, I had cocaine in my possession.

I took me quite some time but I am clean and sober and have my family back together. I now own and operate Wings N Things, a business that has been in the community for 25 years and I am very proud of it. I tried going to NA and AA meetings and they worked for a while but I would always start hanging around with the other addicts who would sometimes make not so good choices and I would also make these bad choices, I am not blaming the program or the people that attend I am responsible for my own actions, I just don't feel the program was for me, I decided to put the energy and time I was spending on the program into my children, my home and my work and it worked out much better for me. I have gained my 4 children's trust and respect back as well as my family and friends, it was a long hard road but I am in such a good place and so happy in my life now. I was on probation but they felt I was doing so well they let me off 1 ½ years early and the DA actually made me cupcakes she was so impressed with my change.

Recently Buffalo Wild Wings has opened up a few blocks down and serves alcohol. I think it would be great for my business to serve beer and wine as I get many requests for it. I have had people walk out because they wanted to have a beer with their wings. We have had a beer and wine license before with a previous owner and I worked here and we did not ever have any problems.

I have worked extremely hard to get where I am today and rebuild my life. I sincerely hope you will consider my business for the license. Thank you for your time and consideration.

At the December 1, 2014 meeting of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in Anchorage, Alaska, the board voted to issue this new restaurant eating place license with delegation. This means that your license is not ready to issue because you have not received all necessary approvals, but the board was anticipating that you are diligently working on removing the obstacles to your license.

Specifically, the Municipality of Anchorage protested your application pending an administrative site plan review and approvals from building safety and the Anchorage Fire Department. It has now been one year, four months and two weeks since the board delegated this matter and we still have not received notice from the Municipality of Anchorage that it has lifted its protest.

Please plan to appear at the ABC board meeting April 26, 2016, in Anchorage, Alaska, to explain to the board what actions you have taken to get the Municipality of Anchorage's protest lifted since February 11, 2015. You should expect the board to remove the delegation, uphold the protest and deny your license if you cannot demonstrate adequate efforts to get the protest removed. Thanks for your prompt attention to this critical matter.
