RE: Regulation Project: Restaurant  
Designation Permits

This was a regulation project intended to add certain license types to the existing list in 3 AAC 304.715(a) that permits the listed license types to apply for a Restaurant Designation Permit. The license types added in the draft language of the project were created by the legislature after the existing regulation was adopted and were not added to the regulation at the time of their creation.

The draft language in the attached tab was put out for public comment. No public comments on this regulation project were received during the public comment period.

The board may review the draft language and determine whether to adopt the regulation as written, request further work or an additional draft with other language from staff, or close the project without adopting any regulation.

**3 AAC 304.715. Restaurant Designation Permits**

**3 AAC 304.715 is amended to add new language as follows (new language underlined and bolded):**

- (a) A licensee desiring designation under [3 AAC 304.715](#) - [3 AAC 304.795](#) as a bona fide restaurant, hotel, or eating place for purposes of [AS 04.16.010\(c\)](#) or 04.16.049 must file with the director an application, on a form prescribed by the board, together with an initial application fee of \$50. Designation will be granted only to a holder of a beverage dispensary, club, recreational site, golf course, **outdoor recreational lodge, destination resort** or restaurant or eating place license, and only if the requirements of [3 AAC 304.725](#) and [3 AAC 304.745](#), as applicable, are met.
