

**Recreational Site Statement
Alaska Zipline Adventures, LLC

Dear Alcoholic Beverage Control Board:

I am submitting this statement as part of a renewal application for our existing recreational site license that will expire on December 31, 2016. Our operations for the upcoming license period will remain consistent with previous license periods. Every summer Alaska Zipline Adventures offers zipline canopy tours through the rainforest at the base of Eaglecrest Ski Area. Guests of our tour spend approximately 2 hours progressing through our guided zipline course. After the zipline tour is complete, guests have the option of participating in our axe-throwing event before returning to the ski lodge. Once they arrive back at the lodge, participants have approximately 30 minutes to relax and enjoy photos from their tour before departing. During this time back at the lodge, beer is available for guests to purchase. A complimentary snack is provided to all guests, and other food and non-alcoholic beverages are available for purchase as well. Round-trip transportation from downtown Juneau is included for all tours. Below are responses to the mandatory points requested in the license application.

1. Explain what hours you'll be serving beer and wine at your establishment in relation to your event hours.

Beer is available for purchase for 30 minutes after the completion of each zipline tour. Groups will complete their zipline tours as early as 10:30 am or as late as 8:00 pm.

2. What recreational events are regularly held during a season at your establishment?

We offer zipline canopy tours through the subalpine rainforest located at the base of Eaglecrest Ski Area. Zipline participants are accompanied throughout the entire tour by at least two trained guides who clip and unclip them from the zipline cables and assist them on and off tree-based platforms. After completing the zipline



portion of the tour, but before returning to the ski lodge, guides also accompany guests during our optional axe-throwing event. This portion takes about 15 minutes. Guests have the opportunity to try competitive-style axe-throwing similar to the events seen at Juneau's Gold Rush Days and other lumberjack-themed shows around the state.

Once the entire group has completed axe-throwing, participants return to the ski lodge where they remove their gear and receive a complimentary snack. Guests have approximately 30 minutes to relax, watch pictures from their tour, and purchase beer, non-alcoholic beverages, snacks, or souvenirs. Then, guests receive transportation back to downtown Juneau or directly to their cruise ship dock.

3. What is the season of your recreational events?

Our tour season runs from April 15th through October 15th.

Thank you very much for your consideration of our liquor license renewal application. Offering local beer enhances our guests' experience of Alaska and our unique local culture. Considering our close staff supervision of guests, included transportation for all tours, and the brief time for alcohol consumption after tours are completed, we feel our tour provides an exceptionally safe environment for enjoying beer produced here in Juneau.
