

3 AAC 304.340. Common Carrier Dispensary License

3 AAC 304.340 Chapter 3 “Common Carrier Dispensary License” is amended to add new sections (e), (f), (g), and (h) as follows:

3AAC 304.340 Common Carrier Dispensary License

(e) For purposes of AS 04.11.180(a), a boat licensed for a state or federal agency for passenger travel includes a 12-pack uninspected marine vessel only if the marine vessel has 3 or more staterooms for overnight passenger travel. No other type of uninspected marine vessel qualifies as a common carrier for purposes of obtaining a common carrier dispensary license, unless it is licensed by a state or federal agency for passenger travel.

(f) Notwithstanding any other provision in AS 04.16.049, a person 16 or 17 years of age may enter and remain within the licensed premises of a common carrier in the course of employment if (1) the employment does not involve the serving, selling, mixing, delivering, or dispensing of alcoholic beverages; (2) the person has the written consent of a parent or guardian; and (3) an exemption from the prohibition of [AS 23.10.355](#) is granted by the Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

(g) Notwithstanding any other provision in AS 04.16.049, a person 18, 19, or 20 years of age may enter and remain within the licensed premises of a common carrier in the course of employment if the employment does not involve serving, selling, mixing, delivering, or dispensing of alcoholic beverages.

(h) Notwithstanding any other provision in AS 04.16.049, a person under the age of 21 may enter and remain within the licensed premises of a common carrier during passenger travel without a parent or guardian.
