On March 20, 2017, Girdwood Brewing Company, LLC Co-Owner/Brew Engineer Rory Marenco received a phone call from the Alaska Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office (AMCO) Enforcement Supervisor James Hoelscher. Mr. Hoelscher informed Mr. Marenco that Girdwood Brewing Company, LLC (GBC) was out of compliance because its brewery license had not yet been issued. That same day, Mr. Marenco emailed Mr. Hoelscher the correspondence from the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) and AMCO conveying the brewery license approval. Based on this correspondence, GBC had a good faith belief that License No. 5118 had been approved and it began operations on March 16, 2017.

Upon being notified by Mr. Hoelscher of its non-compliance, and informed by Mr. Hoelscher that a site inspection was required, GBC immediately scheduled the site inspection with AMCO. The site inspection occurred on March 22, 2017 and License No. 5118 was issued that same day.

On March 30, 2017, GBC received Notice of Violation No. AB17-0124 for operating without a license. As explained above, GBC had a reasonable good faith belief that its brewery license application had been approved based on communications from and with the MOA and AMCO. After being contacted by Mr. Hoelscher, GBC immediately rectified the situation before resuming brewing operations. Specifically, GBC was notified of the issue on March 20<sup>th</sup>, was closed March 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>, and did not resume operations until March 23<sup>rd</sup> (after the site inspection was conducted and the license issued).

Please note that License No. 5118 is currently posted in a visible location in the GBC brewery premises as required by State law. Further, GBC understands that this license is required to be renewed biennially per AS 04.11.130(d) and has docketed the renewal date in its calendar. Further, GBC understands that

additional inspections may be required at that time. Accordingly, GBC feels confident that a reoccurrence of this violation is very unlikely.

Compliance with AMCO statutory and regulatory law is of the utmost important to the Girdwood Brewing Company. This violation was unintentional and solely due to GBC's unfamiliarity with the nuances of the AMCO licensing procedures. We respectfully request that AMCO find the corrective actions taken by GBC to date, and the preventative measures implemented by GBC, acceptable and sufficient.

On June 1, 2017 the Wood Center Pub and the University of Alaska Fairbanks received a Notice of Violation from the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office. The Notice alleges violations of AS 04.16.015 due to eight different Facebook posts offering drink specials for less than a calendar week.

AS 04.16.015(b) prohibits certain off-premises advertising defined in AS 04.16.015(a). Specifically, AS 04.16.015(a)(3) prohibits the sale, offer to sell, or delivery of alcoholic beverages at a price less than the regular price for the beverage during the same calendar week. "Calendar week" is not defined in AS 04.21.080 or associated regulations.

I consulted with Wood Center Pub staff in responding to this Notice. Staff confirmed that all of the specials referenced in the Notice ran for seven consecutive days. The understanding that specials could be offered for seven consecutive calendar days was based on instructions employees received at their TAMs classes.

The alleged violations appear to be based on the Wood Center Pub's incorrect interpretation of the meaning of "calendar week." The term "calendar week" is not defined in state statute or regulations and Wood Center Pub staff understood calendar week to mean any seven consecutive days. Our additional research suggests that "calendar week" actually means Sunday through Saturday, and I would appreciate confirmation that this definition is consistent with AMCO's interpretation.

I have taken this opportunity to educate all Wood Center Pub managers and staff about the restrictions on pricing and marketing alcoholic beverages pursuant to AS 04.16.015. I met with all Wood Center Pub staff and clarified the meaning of calendar week as I now understand it. As a result of this additional training, the Wood Center Pub will no longer offer specials starting mid-week. Moreover, all advertisements for drink specials will clearly state that they run for at least a calendar week.
