Tourism Statement

Mt. McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge borders the south side of Denali National Park on the banks of the Chulitna River. McKinley.

Enjoy sophisticated cuisine and panoramic views in the Mountain View Restaurant, casual fare in the Cub Café, or the venue on the south side of Denali, 20,320 Alaskan Bar & Grill named for the height of Mt. McKinley. Or, choose appetizers and your favorite refreshment in The Hangar, the Grizzly Bar or while relaxing on the outdoor terrace. At Mt. McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge we cater to our guest's every whim. The issuance of a liquor license makes the transition from ship amenities to shoreside amenities comparable for guests - with the dining facilities available at the hotel the ability to serve alcohol to complement the meals is important.

During 2016 and 2017 a Treehouse venue was added on the Hill Trail. There were also restaurant renovations that took place at Mountain View Restaurant including a new layout, furniture and fireplace.

Alcoholic beverages are not stocked in guest rooms.
