RE: Regulations Change: Alternating  
Premises

**Requested Action:** Open a regulations project; amend and/or put draft out for public comment

**Statutory Authority:** AS 04.06.100(a): "The board shall adopt regulations governing the manufacture, barter, sale, consumption, and possession of alcoholic beverages in the state that are consistent with this title and necessary to carry out the purpose of this title in a manner that will protect the public health, safety, and welfare."

**Staff Rec.:** Open a regulations project; put draft out for public comment

**Background:** The board approved alternating licensed premises for Dave and Buster's (#806), a beverage dispensary license, on October 26, 2016. The alternating licensed premises concept at 3 AAC 304.225 currently is not authorized for beverage dispensary licenses. This regulations change adds beverage dispensary licenses as a license type eligible for alternating licensed premises.

3 AAC 304.225(a) is amended to read:

(a) Upon a licensee’s written request accompanied by a detailed premises diagram, the board may approve a portion of a premises licensed under **AS 04.11.090 (beverage dispensary license)**, AS 4.11.100 (restaurant eating place license), AS 4.11.115 (golf course license), AS 04.11.180 (common carrier dispensary license), AS 04.11.210 (recreational site license), AS 04.11.225 (outdoor recreational lodge license), AS 04.11.255 (destination resort license), or AS 04.11.400(d) to alternate as a licensed or unlicensed premises under the following conditions:
