

This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

Keeton advised that through Facebook, her employer told her to get a card but did not follow through with checking to see if Keeton was in compliance. This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

VIOLATION: On 8-16-16, it was learned that you are providing entertainment in the restaurant portion of your licensed premises. Your restaurant designation permit application indicates you do not provide entertainment. Twice since the inspection you requested time to sell or remove the entertainment and were given until 9-1-16. You stated you would notify AMCO when you corrected the violation by either removing entertainment or surrendering your RDP. As of 9-12-16, you have failed to notify AMCO the status of the entertainment. This is a violation of Title 04.

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


