TOURISM STATEMENT FOR Al's Alaskan Inn

(2018/2019 RENEWAL APPLICATION)

- 1) Renewal and Issuance of Al's Alaskan Inn's Liquor License #10 has encouraged tourism by providing affordable housing to tourists, a historical Alaskan Experience, and an opportunity for tourists to meet locals/tourists in order to gain firsthand knowledge of fishing/camping/guiding, and historical destinations during their travels. We also provide entertainment such as Karaoke and Live Local Bands, free chili nights, snacks, as well as free outdoor BBQ events. Tourists travel from all over the world to experience Al's Alaskan Inn and it's friendly and diversified clients and complete their bucket list of singing karaoke in all 50 States or meet people and acquire jobs in order to move to Alaska.
- 2) Al's Alaskan Inn was established in 1967 under the State of Alaska Grandfathered requirement to have 10 sleeping rooms, although my Father and Mother added an additional 9 rooms in the late 1970's because of need for additional rooms during the Trans-Alaska Pipeline Boom at the time. We are in the process of adding an additional 10 rooms on the second floor where there were previously 2 additional fixed bars approved by the ABC Board in 2002. These are currently framed in place.
- 3) Allen Henry Choy and Sarah Annalyn Alexander live on-site and jointly manage all daily operations of the motel and bar facility 7 days per week. We have one part-time bartender and motel operator which is Heatherlyn Blosser-Campbell.
- 4) We offer 19 motel rooms to the traveling public. 6 motel rooms have complete kitchen facilities, which is the State Requirement under the guidelines requiring Al's Alaskan Inn to only have 10 motel rooms with a majority containing kitchenettes. We do not stock Alcoholic Beverages in the rooms.
- Al's Alaskan Inn is not required to have a Dining Facility and we do not have Dining Facility.
 After the Economic Recession is over we will are considering a small Dining Facility in the Bar.
- 6) Al's Alaskan Inn provides flyers and brochures from the Anchorage Visitors Center for Tourists to review in order to determine their best chosen fishing, hiking, camping and historical destinations.
