All fields of this form must be complete and correct, or the application will be returned to you in the manner in which it was received, per AS 04.11.270 and 3 AAC 304.105. The Community Council field only should be verified/completed by licensees whose establishments are located within the Municipality of Anchorage or outside of city limits within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.

This form must be completed correctly and submitted to the Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office (AMCO)’s main office, along with all other required documents and fees, before any renewal license application will be considered complete.





Dear Control Office,

Clover Bay Lodge operates a floating lodge and charter fishing business for three months per year. The lodge operates out of beautiful Clover Bay on Prince of Wales Island in Alaska. The design of the lodges facilities have not varied from the design that the Alaska Alcoholic Beverage Control Board has long approved of.


The lodge serves 12 parties of three with 12 beautiful staterooms. Each stateroom has a bedroom and a bathroom but does not have kitchen facilities or room refrigerators. Guests are not allowed or provided with in room alcohol.

Clover Bay Lodge does not offer room rentals to the traveling public. It only offers rooms to guests who buy a fishing charter and receive their room as part of a package that includes three days of fishing charters, and meals. The majority of our customers are out of state tourists who come to see Alaska and catch fish.

A liquor license greatly facilitates tourism at our lodge. Our guests come to the lodge primarily to fish, but after a day of fishing, guests prefer to tell their embellished fish stories over a cold beer or cocktail.

This business has been in continual seasonal operation since 1983. We respectfully request that a new liquor license be granted for the future success of the lodge.


