Staff Rec.: Approve the renewal

Background: This recreational site license appears to meet the statutory requirements of the license type:

Sec. 04.11.210. Recreational site license.

(a) The holder of a recreational site license may sell beer and wine at a recreational site during and one hour before and after a recreational event that is not a school event, for consumption on designated areas at the site.

(b) The biennial fee for a recreational site license is \$800.

(c) In this section, "recreational site" includes a location where baseball games, car races, hockey games, dog sled racing events, or curling matches are regularly held during a season.

The board should clarify with the licensee that events where alcohol is served under this license must be limited to competitive sporting events in order to comply with AS 04.11.210. This is consistent with direction the board provided to License #4895, AK Tuesday Night Fights, where the licensed premises (the Curtis Menard Sports Complex in Wasilla) can be used for non-sporting events such as concerts. Music concerts and other non-sporting events held at the licensed premises would need to have permits in order for alcohol to be served. An alternating premises approval appears also to be necessary as areas of the licensed premises, including seating and the facility promenade are likely used by unaccompanied minors at various times when alcohol is not being served.






