Staff Rec.: Reconsider denial of license renewal

Background: The City of Dillingham protested the renewal of this license for non-payment of taxes and utility bills. The board upheld the protest with a 30-day abeyance at the June 2018 meeting. The board required the protest to be lifted by the 30-day deadline, which was July 19, 2018 (30 days after the licensee was notified of the board's action).

On July 20, 2018, I expired the license because the City of Dillingham had not lifted their protest. A few days later AMCO was contacted by a lawyer for the licensee stating that the licensee had paid their taxes and utility bills on July 10, 2018. We confirmed this with the City of Dillingham, but the protest was not lifted until August 2, 2018.

I recommend that the board reconsider its action at the June meeting and renew the license.
