Staff Rec.: Approve the renewal after evaluation of hours of operation

Background: This recreational site license appears to meet the statutory requirements of the license type:

Sec. 04.11.210. Recreational site license.

- (a) The holder of a recreational site license may sell beer and wine at a recreational site during and one hour before and after a recreational event that is not a school event, for consumption on designated areas at the site.
- (b) The biennial fee for a recreational site license is \$800.
- (c) In this section, "recreational site" includes a location where baseball games, car races, hockey games, dog sled racing events, or curling matches are regularly held during a season.

The board should evaluate whether the hours of operation of this license are in excess of the allowances of the statute. Hockey games are listed as one example of eligible events, but it appears that this license is also exercised in relation to hockey practices and other skating activity, and is operated year round, not "during a season."

Re: Comment on Recreation Site License Renewals

Dear Ms. McConnell:

Please accept this letter as comment on the examination of recreation site license renewals noticed for hearing at the August 14, 2018, AMCB meeting at the "Grand Denali Lodge" submitted here by licensee: O'Malley Ice & Sports LLC dba the Blue Line Pub, License No. 3968.

The Blue Line Pub has been a successful and compliant licensee since the year 2000 and its license has been recommended for renewal. However we note that in the renewal recommendation Staff has also recommended that the Board should: "evaluate whether the hours of operation of the Licensee are in excess of the allowance of the <u>Statute</u>" (emph. added).

We believe that Licensees such as the Blue Line Pub are operating within the letter and intent of the express language of the Statute. The Statute, AS 04.11.210 by its express terms states the limitation of the hours of operation in sub-section (a) stating: The licensee may sell beer and wine "one hour before and one hour after a recreational event". As in this case, when the Statute expressly addresses the hours of operation, other interpretation of the Statute is not lawful or proper especially where the interpretation may adversely affect or eliminate a previously granted and compliant license to engage in business.

Staff's observation that the Blue Line sells beer and wine after "practices and other skating activity" does not address the hours of operation. The issue if any (and the Blue Line Pub does not agree or concede there is an issue) pertains to the nature of the "recreation event' conducted. What is a qualifying "recreation event" under the Statute is not a subject or matter that may arbitrarily re-defined by Staff interpretation or practice. Particularly since the Statute by its express terms allows for service after "a recreational event that is not a school event."

The Statute does not restrict the nature of the recreational events taking place, except to exclude school events. The legislature could have further defined "recreational event" and it chose not to. It only conditioned the term, "recreation event" to exclude "school events". The Blue Line Pub affirmatively asserts that "practices and other skating activity" are in fact proper "recreational events" under the Statute. If this Board believes the terms of the Statute are no longer adequate to govern the nature of events conducted at "Recreational Sites" the correct action is to request a modification of the Statute by the Legislature. The Legislature is the only body empowered to modify law codified as express Statute.

Should this Board conclude that "recreation event" under the Statute requires modification, hearings, fact finding and full examination of the issue before the Legislature is the appropriate manner to address this issue. Particularly when, the matter involves existing and compliant business operations as opposed to proposed or hypothetical business plans. The Blue Line Pub does not believe any modification is necessary as demonstrated by its compliance and overall contributions to the active sporting community since the year 2000.

Thank you for admitting this letter into the record and listening to the comments provided herein.

The "Blueline Pub and Café" located within the Subway Sports Center

Located at 11111 O'Malley Center Drive Anchorage Alaska

O'Malley Ice and Sports Center the Licensee, has operated the Blue Line Pub and Café within the 70,000 square foot Subway Sports Center since January 1, 2000. The Subway Sports Center is a recreational skating facility providing two ice skating rinks that hosts hockey games, practices and recreational play year-round. Other hosted sports hosted include figure skating, speed skating, curling and other. The facility also includes an elevated running track, fitness activity space and a restaurant serving beer and wine known as the Blueline Pub. The skating rinks are open 350 days per year usually opening at 6:00 a.m. and closing at 12:00 a.m. The Subway sports center experiences about 360,000 visitations on an annual basis. The Blueline is located on a mezzanine area within the Subway Center.

The Blueline serves a full menu of hot entrées, beer, wine coffee and soft-drinks. A copy of the menu is attached. The Blueline Pub operates on all days the skating rinks are open, ordinarily opening at noon and closing at midnight. On weekends and holidays when skating activity begins during the morning the blueline will open by 9;00 am. Beer and wine service ordinarily begins at noon and concludes one hour after the last skating activity, which is usually midnight. The Blueline serves food and beer and wine one hour before and after the conclusion of skating activity subject to the overall operating hours described above. During special events and tournaments, the operating hours will extend to follow the tournament skating activity but in all circumstances the Blueline is closed not later than 2:00 am.

The Blueline is managed by a full-time, professional food and beverage manager. All beverage service personnel receive "TAPs" training. The full time equivalent staff comprises eight to ten persons depending on the season. Inventory purchases and sales are continuously recorded and reported as a separate profit and loss class within a CPA reviewed financial statement. The executive management of the O'Malley Ice and Sports Center and its Blueline Pub continues to be the two individuals who founded the facility in 1999, Mr. Steve Agni and Mr. Sig Jokiel.
