Anchorage-Lakefront Ltd Partnership dba The Lakefront Anchorage – A Millennium Hotel has filed a Transfer Application with the Alaska Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office. This statement is being submitted as part of the application.

The Lakefront Anchorage is a tourist destination in Anchorage, Alaska which as built along the eastern shore of Lake Spenard and amidst many outdoor attractions in this area of Alaska. Just minutes from the Anchorage International Airport, the Hotel is ideally situated for tourists.

We are members of many tourism destination marketing organizations such as Visit Anchorage, Alaska Tourism Industry Association, Fairbanks Convention and Visitors Bureau and the local chamber of commerce's located in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau, Soldotna, Kenai and Ketchikan. Our sales team travels to a number of trade shows promoting not only the hotel but the state of Alaska to domestic and international tour operators, travel agents and independent travelers. The Hotel has its own floatplane dock to take tourists on excursion flights to see Alaska's great outdoors. In the summer, we have an Adventure desk that recommends tours and activities.

The Hotel has 248 guest rooms and 7 meeting rooms which is attractive to business tourists looking for an ideal scenic location in Alaska to host business meeting accommodating up to 300 attendees with extensive audio/video equipment and technicians.

Guest rooms do not have kitchen facilities or stocked alcoholic beverages; however, there are three restaurants within The Hotel to accommodate dining requests. Two year-round restaurants, the Fancy Moose Lounge, offering dining for lunch and dinner, the Flying Machine restaurant, open daily for breakfast, lunch and dinner during the summer tourism season only and breakfast only during the winter, and a seasonal outdoor restaurant called the Deck at Lake Hood. During the past few years we have made significant improvements to the property which included renovating both restaurants, deck, lobby and meeting rooms as well as a complete renovation of our guest rooms, corridors and exterior. We just completed modernizing our elevators.

Our senior management team is very active in the community and we value charity partnerships that strengthen our ties to the City and with our patrons. We have over 80 full time Alaskans working at the Hotel. We are proud of our establishment and look forward to the continued safe serving of alcohol in the future.
