This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

Note: This is not an accusation or a criminal complaint.

AMCO Investigators were monitoring Facebook social media and observed one of your posts from 7-26-18. The advertising post says there is a garage sale to honor our heroes. It advertises "Special on Budweiser Pints, only \$3.75, Saturday, July 28th from 10am-3pm, rain or shine!". This is a violation.

Your attention is referred to AS04.16.015: Pricing and marketing

You are directed to respond in writing to this Notice of Violation within 10 days of receipt to explain what action you have taken to prevent a re-occurrence of this violation. FAILURE TO RESPOND TO THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION WITHIN 10 DAYS WILL RESULT IN YOUR APPREARANCE, EITHER IN PERSON OR TELEPHONICALLY, BEFORE THE ABC BOARD AT THEIR NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING.

\*Please send your response to the address below and include your alcohol license number in your response.

3 AAC 304.525 (B) provides that upon receipt of a Notice of Violation, a licensee may request to appear before the Director and be heard regarding the Notice of Violation. The request must be made within ten days after receipt of the Notice and the Director must grant an appearance within ten days after receipt of a request. A Licensee shall respond, either orally or in writing, to the Notice.



The poster shows the date and time of the garage sale and also shows the dates from July 16<sup>th</sup> thru July 28<sup>th</sup> that \$1.50 of each Budweiser sold would be donated to the charity. During that time Budweiser Pints were being sold for \$3.75 and we actually sold Budweiser Pints for \$3.75 from the 16<sup>th</sup> of July to the 30<sup>th</sup> of July. I also want to mention the garage sale was in the parking lot and we did not have alcohol available during the garage sale in the parking lot or any other food or drink. Any inference that we were going to sale Budweiser for \$3.75 on that day only was not intentional and in the future we will do a better job scrutinizing any advertising we do.
