GrayRobinson, P.A. represents Anchorage Lakefront Limited Partnership ("Anchorage"). We recently filed an application with the Alaska Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office ("AMCO") to update the officers of Regal Hotel Management, Inc. ("Regal"). Regal is the general partner of Anchorage. As this application to update the officers of Regal was being processed by the AMCO it was brought to our attention that there was a change of limited partner for Anchorage. CDL Hotel USA, Inc.'s interest, as the 99% limited partner, was transferred to Cincinnati S.I.CO. Regal continues to hold 1% general partnership interest in Anchorage. Anchorage did not realize this internal change required a filing with the AMCO. Since receiving the notice requiring Anchorage to file this change we have been preparing the Transfer Application disclosing the changes which should be submitted to the AMCO on or before September 7, 2018.

Our client now understands that changes including general partner and officers of licensed entities are required to be reported to AMCO and to the Alaska Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing.

He was not aware that when he incorporated his business in 2009 and obtained a business license in the name of the new entity that he would be in violation of the alcohol licensing law. It was not his intention to transfer the license to the new entity in violation of the law. He overlooked the impact on the license with creation of the new entity and new business license. As you can tell from the history he has had no problems with this license in the past.

Mr. Kang wants to take whatever steps are necessary to rectify this problem. He will obtain a business license as a sole proprietor dba as Milano's Pizzaria. Mr. Kang recognizes that he may not be permitted to obtain a business license for Milano's Pizzaria since that is the same name used by the entity Milano's Pizzaria Inc. Assuming that is the case he will consider dropping the business license for Milano's Pizzaria Inc. In addition he will, this week, begin preparation of the transfer paperwork to Milano's Pizzaria, Inc.

Let us know if there is anything else that Mr. Kang should do to address this violation.

Thank you for bringing to my attention the concern that the transfer in the "form of ownership" of Sukakpak, Inc. from Brett Carlson, Lee Kenaston, and Matthew Atkinson to Soulstice, Inc. may represent a change in the controlling interest associated with the Sukakpak, Inc beverage dispensary license [Notice of Violation pasted below] --- in reality, the identified change in "form of ownership" represents a technical change recommended by our accountant to address the accounting/tax needs of our business --- the controlling interest in Sukakpak, Inc is unchanged, as the exact same individuals own a controlling interest in Sukakpak, Inc through their controlling interest in Soulstice, Inc. in the exact same percentages as existed previously --- AS Sec. 04.11.040 (c) refers to transfers of <u>controlling interests</u> in a liquor license which does seem to be applicable to this case ---
