**Background:** At the October 2018 meeting of the board, the board upheld the Municipality of Anchorage's protest of the 2017/2018 renewal of these licenses for taxes due, with a 30 day abeyance. The licensee was sent a letter stating that he was required to have the MOA protest lifted by November 18, 2018, or the licenses would expire. The licensee did not pay his taxes and have the protests lifted by the deadline, so the licenses were expired on November 19.

The licensee is requesting an informal conference with the board under AS 04.11.510(b)(1). He has paid the taxes and the MOA has lifted the protests. The licensee is requesting reinstatement and renewal.

Please note that at the October meeting, the board also approved transfer applications that were contingent on the renewal of the licenses. If the board reinstates and renews these licenses, the board should affirm that the transfers remain approved with delegation.

Mr. Burt,

The October 19 letters of board action provided to the licensee stated that the municipal protest <u>must be lifted by</u> November 18, not just that the taxes be paid. Because the protests were not lifted by the deadline, the licenses have been expired. I recommend the licensee request an informal conference with me. At that informal conference, I will explain to them that they will need to request reinstatement from the board. If the conference is held before November 30 and the request for reinstatement is received before November 30, which is the deadline for agenda items for the next board meeting, the request will be placed on the December 17 ABC Board meeting agenda for board consideration. I have no authority to reinstate an expired license.

Please let me know if you have any additional questions. I will be out of the office tomorrow and AMCO will be closed on Thursday for the holiday and on Friday for a mandatory furlough day.

Our client, Kenny Lee, received notice of the Municipality of Anchorage's protest of renewal of his license renewal application for license #4123 and #4529 with a deadline for November 18. As November 18 was a Sunday, Mr. Lee was unable to pay them on that day. Today, on Monday, he paid off all his unpaid taxes. I've attached the receipts for the Muni taxes. As of the payment of the taxes the Muni lifts its protest. While Mr. Lee was paying his taxes at the Muni office, AMCO employees removed the liquor licenses from Ding How and Samurai Sushi. These licenses must be returned immediately. Mr. Lee's restaurants open at 11 AM tomorrow. Please call me prior to that time to arrange returning of those licenses.
