Requested Action: Approve new license application.

Statutory and Regulatory Authority: AS 04.06.090(b): “The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title.”

AS 04.11.100(d) “The board may approve
(1) the issuance of a new beverage dispensary or restaurant or eating place license without regard to (a) of this section if it appears that the issuance will encourage the tourist trade by encouraging the construction or improvement of
(A) a hotel, motel, resort, or similar business relating to the tourist trade with a dining facility or having kitchen facilities in a majority of its rental rooms and at least a minimum number of rental rooms required according to the population of the incorporated city, unified municipality, or population area established under (a) of this section in which the facility will be located, as follows:

- (i) 10 rental rooms if the population is less than 1,501;
- (ii) 20 rental rooms if the population is 1,501 — 2,500;
- (iii) 25 rental rooms if the population is 2,501 — 5,000;
- (iv) 30 rental rooms if the population is 5,001 — 15,000;
- (v) 35 rental rooms if the population is 15,001 — 25,000;
- (vi) 40 rental rooms if the population is 25,001 — 50,000; and
- (vii) 50 rental rooms if the population is greater than 50,000; or

Staff Rec.: Approve new license application.

Background: A completed new license application has been received for license 5673 DBA McKinley Creekside Cabins located in the Denali Borough. AS 04.11.400(d)(1)(B) requires 20 rental rooms if the population is 1,501-2,500. The Denali Borough has a certified population of 1,576. The

applicant offers 45 rental rooms, none of which have kitchenettes. Alcohol is not stocked in guest rooms and the establishment has a full service restaurant.

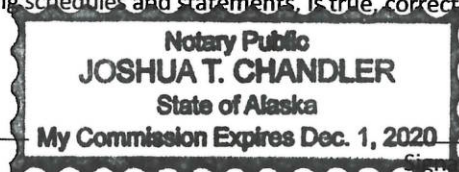

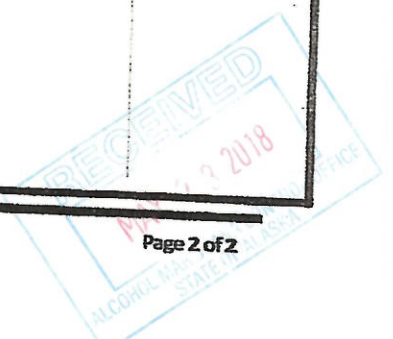
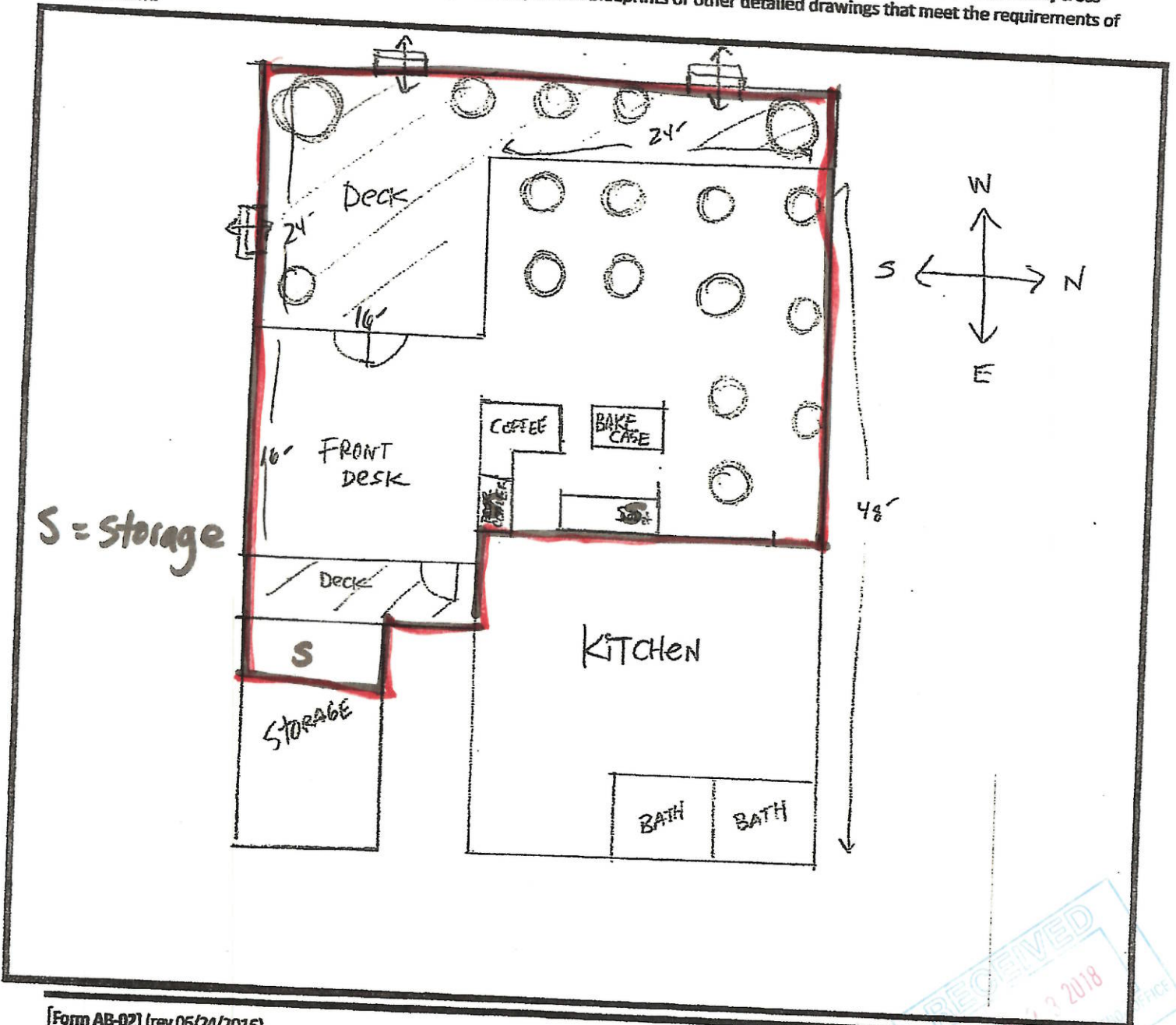

Good morning, Holly

After a review of the application and in light of the premises issues, the following items need some clarifications before we finalize for the upcoming board meeting:

- AB-02 Diagram: As I understand it, the licensed premises will be the restaurant & deck. Is the attached diagram accurate?

YES, The back "deck" from the front desk is just a walkway to the storage area. Not a seating area.

- AB-03 Diagram: Same as above, but this one does not include the deck by the kitchen. Is this accurate for the purposes of individuals under 21 years being employed and dining at your establishment?

Yes, As described above....this is just a walkway to the storage

- Security Plan: The plan we have focuses mostly on the fire pit and pavilion area. Can I get an updated narrative just for the deck with no mention of the other areas?

(letter dated 6/26/18) The security plan is no longer needed. We are not including the fire pit and pavilion area. We are just upgrading our license from a beer/wine to a beverage dispensary license,... so we can do out own caterers permits when need be. We already have a license for our designated areas, shown on the maps above. We are not changing the licensed area, ONLY the license. So you can discard that letter with our packet.

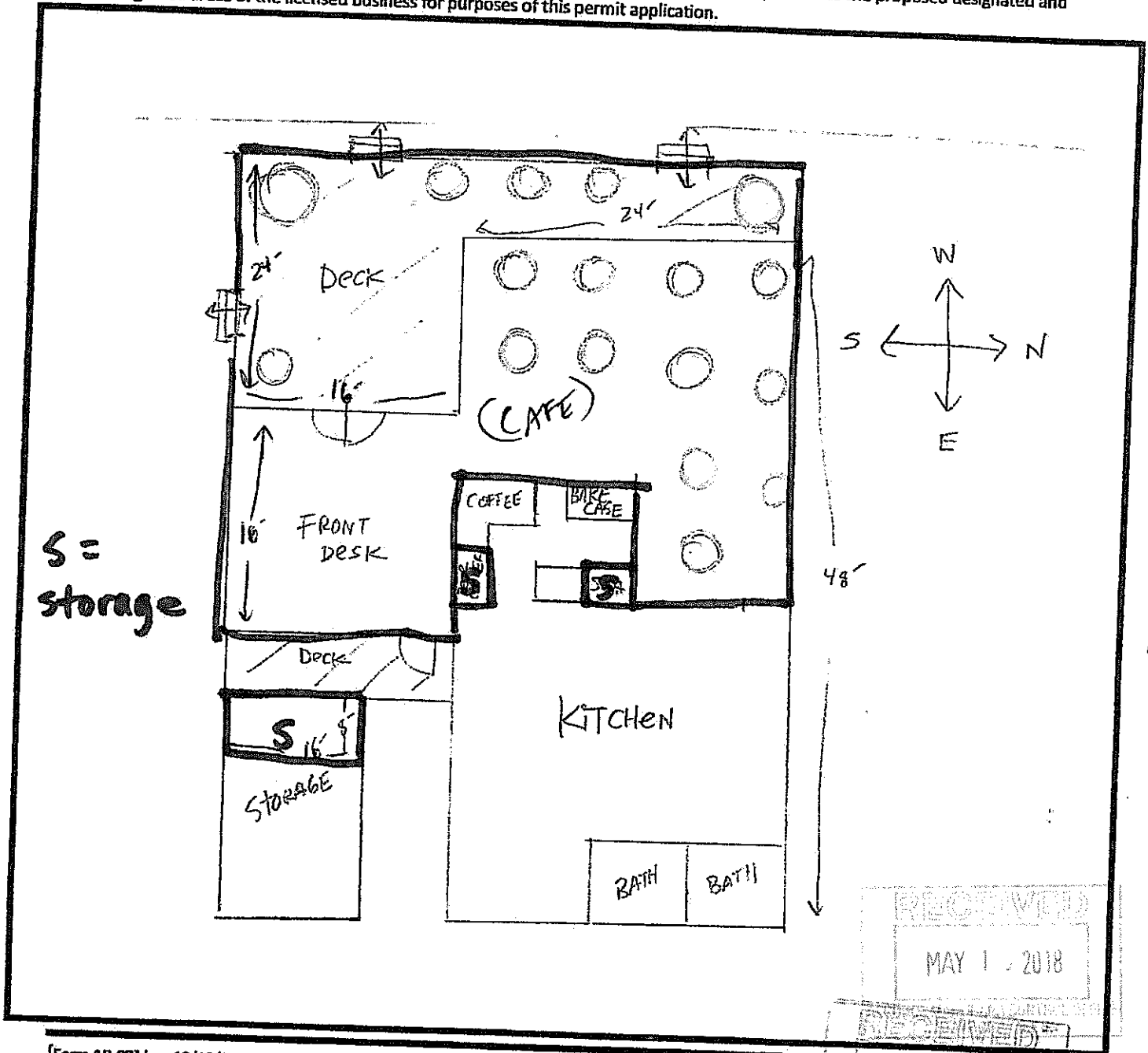

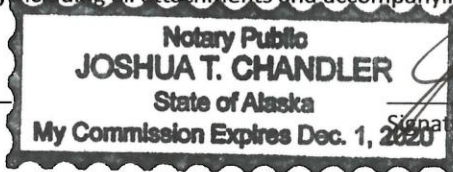
