This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

Note: This is not an accusation or a criminal complaint.

On 10/22/2018 AMCO Enforcement received information VFW Post #7056 was hosting events inviting members of the public to the licensed club premises. VFW Post #7056 Director, Dewey BELL contacted AMCO Enforcement and stated they had been open to the public for Sunday brunch on 10/21/2018. I advised BELL of the restrictions of a club license and followed up by sending an advisory notice to the licensee via the email address on file on 10/30/2018 informing them the club license does not allow the solicitation of public patronage to the licensed premises.

AMCO Enforcement later received information VFW Post #7056 posted announcements on community Facebook pages soliciting public patronage of the club licensed premises on the following dates:

11/09/2018: VFW Steak Night, Friday, Nov. 9th, 5-9 PM

11/26/2018: VFW Breakfast, 9:00 am to 1:00 pm

12/16/2018: VFW Breakfast Sunday, 9:00 am to 1:00 pm

V.F.W. Katmai Post #7056 Treasurer Tony PARKER, responded to a comment regarding the 11/09/2018 event when a person asked if it was for members only. PARKER replied, "No anyone can stop by and have dinner."

PARKER posted the Facebook advertisements for the 11/26/2018 and 12/16/2018 breakfast events. Included in the post for the 11/26/2018 breakfast was "This is Sunday breakfast is always open to the community."

Soliciting of public patronage of a club premises except as approved by the board is a violation of A.S. 04.11.110(b).

Your attention is drawn to A.S. 04.11.110: Club License and 3 AAC 304.355: Club License.

You are directed to respond in writing to this Notice of Violation within 10 days of receipt to explain what action you have taken to prevent a re-occurrence of this violation. FAILURE TO RESPOND TO THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION WITHIN 10 DAYS WILL RESULT IN YOUR APPEARANCE, EITHER IN PERSON OR TELEPHONICALLY, BEFORE THE ABC BOARD AT THEIR NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING.

3 AAC 304.525 (B) provides that upon receipt of a Notice of Violation, a licensee may request to appear before the Director and be heard regarding the Notice of Violation. The request must be made within ten days after receipt of the Notice and the Director must grant an appearance within ten days after receipt of a request. A Licensee shall respond, either orally or in writing, to the Notice.


