Requested Action: New Restaurant or Eating Place – Public Convenience license

Statutory and Regulatory Authority: AS 04.06.090(b): “The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title.”

AS 04.11.400(g): “The board may approve the issuance or transfer of ownership of a restaurant or eating place license in a municipality without regard to (a) [population limits] of this section if the board finds that issuance or transfer of the license is necessary for the public convenience.”

3 AAC 304.335: “(a) The board may issue a restaurant or eating place license under AS 04.11.400(g) upon a showing that
(1) repealed 8/24/2001;
(2) there is community support, which must be shown by a petition signed by a majority of the residents 21 years of age or over who reside within one mile of the proposed premises; and
(3) the governing body of the municipality in which the licensed premises are to be located approves the application.”

3 AAC 304.115(a): “...Petition signatures must be obtained within the 90-day period immediately preceding the submission of the application. After an application has been filed, no additional signatures may be added to the petition, and no signatures may be withdrawn.”

Staff Rec.: Approve with delegation

Background: This application is for a new restaurant or eating place – public convenience license in the Denali Borough. 3 AAC 304.335 requires approval of the local governing body and community support as expressed by a petition signed by a majority of the residents 21 years of age or older who live within one mile of the proposed licensed premises.

The applicant determined the number of signatures required by identifying the number of residences within a mile of the proposed licensed premises through communication with the Denali Borough.

Using these methods, it was determined that the number of required signatures is 0. Staff verified that there are no permanent residents in the area through communication with the Denali Borough; therefore, no signatures are required.

To Whom it may concern,

Regarding M&M Moose-Aka's Liquor License Application, I, Michael Waring, am requesting to remove my AB-08a from the rest of the application documents since my background investigation has been conducted within the last 5 years.

I have also been instructed to write a security plan in which I address the personnel and practices that I will use to prevent the transfer of alcohol across the premise boundary and the access of alcohol by a minor. At no time will the deck be out of view of no less than two Charr certified Responsible Alcohol Professionals. Maja Waring (company President) acts as the Maître d'. She will be on the floor during all hours of operation, as well as two servers who are Charr certified alcohol professionals, and one bartender who is also a Charr certified alcohol professional. In the event that Maja has to leave the floor at least 2 alcohol professionals will remain on the floor. The westward facing wall of the restaurant has a large window and glass door leading to the patio, so it is visible from any point of the restaurant dining areas. All alcohol professionals are aware of the laws preventing minors from consuming alcohol and preventing alcohol from being removed from the restaurant's legal serving premises. If at any time these laws are broken the responsible professional will be terminated. The patio itself is raised from ground level with a 4 ft wooden enclosure with only one 4-foot opening that has a swinging door that is latched closed during service. There is also a clear hanging retractable enclosure that is attached to the roof and is secured to the top of the 4-foot wooden enclosure. So, in summary the deck is fully enclosed during service and has no less than 2 certified alcohol professionals observing it at all times.

I have also been instructed to write a security plan in which I address the personnel and practices that I will use to prevent the transfer of alcohol across the premise boundary and the access of alcohol by a minor. At no time will the deck be out of view of no less than two Charr certified Responsible Alcohol Professionals. Maja Waring (company President) acts as the Maître d'. In the event that Maja has to leave the floor at least 2 alcohol professionals will remain on the floor. If at any time these laws are broken the responsible professional will be terminated. The patio itself is raised from ground level with a 4 ft wooden enclosure with only one 4-foot opening that has a swinging door that is latched closed during service. There is also a clear hanging retractable enclosure that is attached to the roof and is secured to the top of the 4-foot wooden enclosure. So, in summary the deck is fully enclosed during service and has no less than 2 certified alcohol professionals observing it at all times.
