Requested Action: Request for time extension under AS 04.11.030(b)

Statutory Authority: AS 04.11.030(b): "If an application for the transfer of ownership of a license from a deceased licensee is not made within 90 days of the death of the licensee or within an additional 90 days if an application for transfer of ownership made by the executor is denied, or no petition is made to the board for an extension of time under (c) of this section within the time, the license is forfeited."

AS 04.11.030(c): "The board may extend the time limits in (b) of this section on petition of the executor or administrator."

Background: Licenses 417 and 1295 for 4 Royle Parkers, beverage dispensary and package store licenses, are held by sole proprietors Taek Young & Hee Hwan Lee. Taek Young died on March 16, 2019.

The personal representative of the estate of Taek Young, Edward Jong Hwan Lee, is requesting an extension to file transfers until September 8, 2019.

PETITION FOR EXTENSION

Package Store Liquor License No. 1295

Pursuant to A.S. 04.11.030 (c), petitioner, Edward Jong Hwan Lee, Personal Representative of the Estate of Taek Young Lee, deceased, hereby petitions the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for an extension of ninety (90) days from June 10, 2019 to transfer Package Store Liquor License No. 1295 and Beverage Dispensary Liquor License No. 417. Hee Hwan Lee, is the surviving spouse and current co-licensee with Taek Young Lee, deceased, and will continue doing business as "4 Royal Parkers" at the same location of 36185 Kenai Spur Highway, Soldotna, AK 99669.

The process for transfer of these licenses is underway at this time and publishing will be completed soon at which time the transfer applications and supporting documents will be submitted to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for consideration. This process was delayed due to estate planning and consultations with the estate attorney to determine whether the license should be transferred to Hee Hwan Lee individually or if an LLC would be created with Hee Hwan Lee as the sole member. Those matters have now been concluded and the publication for the transfers has been scheduled.
