Requested License renewal

Action:

**Statutory** Authority: AS 04.06.090(b): "The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title."

AS 04.11.480(a): "A local governing body may protest the issuance, renewal, relocation, or transfer to another person of a license by sending the board and the applicant a protest and the reasons for the protest within 60 days of receipt from the board of notice of filing of the application... The board shall consider a protest and testimony received at a hearing conducted under AS 04.11.510(b)(2) or (4) when it considers the application... If an application or continued operation is protested, the board shall deny the application or continued operation unless the board finds that the protest is arbitrary, capricious, and unreasonable."

AS 04.11.510(b)(2): "The board may review an application for the issuance, renewal, transfer of location, or transfer to another person of a license without affording the applicant notice or hearing, except...(2) the board may, on its own initiative or in response to an objection or protest, hold a hearing to ascertain the reaction of the public or a local governing body to an application if a hearing is not required under this subsection;"

Staff Rec.: Hold a public hearing; deny the application with a 30 day abeyance

**Background:** The City of Cordova protests the renewal of this beverage dispensary license pending payment of delinquent sales taxes.

The licensee should be notified that under 3 AAC 304.145(h), this abeyance period may not be extended or renewed.

#### Susan,

Thank you for this response. We can accept the waive of protest for license #62. But we need to clarify that unless you protest (conditionally) license #61, you will not have the opportunity to protest on July 1 if the licensee does not come into compliance. Your response should state that the city is protesting the renewal of the license on the condition that the licensee pay all delinquent sales taxes by July 1, 2019. This will clarify to the ABC Board the exact situation with this licensee, and allow our office to issue the licensee a "temporary" license so that they may operate during this interim period. But if the city "recommends renewal" that undercuts your recourse if they do not become compliant.

Thanks for all of this info. As far as licenses 61 and 62, Council approved this 2-part motion last week at its regular meeting on April 17.

1) waive it's right to protest approval of the renewal of liquor license #62 (Anchor Liquor Store) for Tiny Wings, Inc.

And.

2) recommend renewal of Liquor License # 61 with the condition that Tiny Wings, dba Anchor Bar & Grill, pays all delinquent sales taxes owing by July 1, 2019 while remaining current on new sales incurred, or the City will protest the renewal with AMCO at that time.

Obviously, the important part is item 2. I've cc'd Dean Baugh, Finance Director, who will be in close contact with the owners of the bar. We will contact you again by July 1 or sooner to let you know the status of the collection of the back taxes.

Hello Susan,

I would like to respond to your comments/questions in this email.

I want to update you on actions taken at recent Council meetings regarding liquor license renewals. At its February 6 regular meeting, Cordova City Council voted to waive its right to protest renewal of license 5508 and license 747.

At its February 20 meeting, Cordova City Council voted to waive its right to protest renewal of license 2433.

Thank you for this.

I assume when the sixty day period of local government protest expires, you usually just move forward on renewals. I have been remiss in responding to you when the City Council takes action such as waiving the right to protest. I will try to remember in the future to send you a quick email when that has occurred on a renewal that is before you.

You are correct, we usually move forward on renewals after the sixty-day period of local government protest expires. If it is a local government that would normally respond to our notices regardless, we try to reach out to make sure we did not actually miss a protest. Nonetheless, if you are ever to timely protest a renewal or a transfer or a new application, please make sure we acknowledged your protest.

There are 2 others that are now before you for renewal, licenses 61 & 62. This business has some financial issues with the City and we are in the process of addressing those. I believe Council has until May 1 to act on whether or not to protest these two renewals. I will be in touch with you

before then to let you know what action Council has chosen.

The protest period for these two license renewal applications expire on 4/29/19, so if we receive a protest after this date, it may not be considered by the ABC Board. Please plan accordingly.

If you want to clarify with the board, please do so. Cordova Council is interested in protesting (for now) with the condition that they pay in full by July 1. At which time we will be in touch with you again to inform you of whether or not they have paid in full or not.

Seems to be semantics either way, but last time, in 2017 when we accomplished this I used the same language. I'll change it for next time.
