Update: At the last meeting, the board tabled action on this renewal and directed staff to develop a policy stating thresholds under which a hotel may provide free alcohol without being licensed. A draft policy has not yet been developed.

The Residence Inn is currently operating under a temporary license.

Background: On the renewal application for the Residence Inn by Marriott, a restaurant or eating place license issued to JL 35th Avenue Hotel Company, the licensee indicated that they have no food receipts or gross receipts. When an inquiry was sent to the licensee, the licensee informed AMCO that this was "due to the fact that <u>we do not (1) have a restaurant at this location</u>, so no retail sales and (2) beer and wine which is dispensed is only provided on a complimentary basis in a controlled environment for hotel guests as part of a required Residence Inn/Marriott brand standard known as the RI Mix. We serve during limited evening hours three days per week complimentary food appetizers and complimentary beer, wine and soft drinks."

AS 04.11.100(b) states, "A license may be issued under this section only if the board determines that the premises to be licensed are a bona fide restaurant or eating place."

AS 04.11.330(a)(6) states that renewal of a license shall be denied if "renewal of the license would violate the restrictions pertaining to the particular license under this title or the license has been operated in violation of a condition or restriction imposed by the board."
