Hello Jason,

I apologize about this violation not already taken care of. I was assured by another person that it was fixed, taken care of and a resolution was came to back in September when the violation occurred. As explained on the phone we have a gas station/convenience store with two separate entrances to keep the Red Diamond Liquor Barn separated from the Vaughn's Mini Mart. We have many signage outside on the building including some that identify us as a Shell Gas station, we sell food, we sell liquor, and we are a convenience store. Each entrance has it's own signage for the business that is on that side - ie: Vaughn's Mini Mart shows their hour and identification on it's entrance and same with Red Diamond Liquor Barn especially since Red Diamond Liquor Barn opens later than Vaughn's Mini Mart. To help clarify the confusion with the other outside signage we purchased a new big vinyl signage that shows which part of the building and separate entrance is the Red Diamond Liquor Barn. I have attached a picture I just took moments ago showing the door with signage on it and the big new vinyl signage on the outside of the building close to the door. I hope this completes everything needed for clearing up our violation. Again I apologize about the very delayed response as it was a miscommunication that this was already resolved. Please let me know if there are more things we still need to do to resolve the violation.





I am writing this letter on behalf of my client Teekell Brothers, Alaska, LLC which operates the Trophy Lounge in Anchorage at Jewel Lake. Please let this letter serve as my client's formal response to NOV AB19-1613 dated October 23, 2019.

As you are aware, my client has already filed a transfer application with your offices to remove Ronald Teekell from the business and liquor license. It is likely that the Board will approve this transfer at the November 2019 meeting.

Ronald Teekell was removed from Teekell Brothers Alaska, LLC in February of this year due to Mr. Teekell's interest in the business being involuntarily forfeited to the Federal Government. The case was resolved by way of plea bargain and Mr. Teekell is now serving time in federal prison. Unfortunately, due to the extreme and sudden nature of this criminal prosecution and related forfeiture, the family did not perform a proper license transfer.

As you know, a transfer has recently been filed to remove Mr. Teekell from the license. Teekell Brothers Alaska, LLC is a long time licensee with a history of compliance with the law. Suffice it to say they take these matters very seriously.

My client and I are available at any time to discuss this matter with you further should you feel such a discussion is necessary. Thank you for your time and courtesy in this regard.
