This letter is regarding First City Saloon licence # 3213.

The City of Ketchikan contacted me about a leak under the building located at 830 Water St Ketchikan, Alaska and told me a permit was required to perform the work. I contacted Mr. Jim Nuzzio at the city office and obtained the required permit and contacted Mike Green of Southeast Plumbing to conduct the work.

In Ketchikan there are only 3 commercial plumbers. Mr. Green instructed me to leave a check

at the local hardware store and he would secure the parts for the repair.

I have enclosed a copy of the check which was left on October 29, 2018 and was processed through my bank on December 12, 2018.

I naturally assumed the work would start as soon as possible.

In February I was contacted by Jim Nuzzio of the City Of Ketchikan stating the work had not been completed which at that time I contacted Mr. Green to find out when the work would be completed. Mr. Green informed me the tides were too high to begin the work

during daylight hours

and Ketchikan had severe winter conditions of 14 degrees for approximately a month.


I have enclosed a letter from Southeast Plumbing stating the work will be completed by March 27, 2019




