### **MEMORANDUM**

TO: Alcoholic Beverage Control Board DATE: June 9, 2020

FROM: Glen Klinkhart, Interim Director RE: 5613 Alaskan Spirits Distillery

Requested Action:

Renewal Application

Statutory Authority: AS 04.06.090(b): "The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title."

AS 04.11.480(a): "A local governing body may protest the issuance, renewal, relocation, or transfer to another person of a license by sending the board and the applicant a protest and the reasons for the protest within 60 days of receipt from the board of notice of filing of the application... The board shall consider a protest and testimony received at a hearing conducted under AS 04.11.510(b)(2) or (4) when it considers the application... If an application or continued operation is protested, the board shall deny the application or continued operation unless the board finds that the protest is arbitrary, capricious, and unreasonable."

AS 04.11.510(b)(2): "The board may review an application for the issuance, renewal, transfer of location, or transfer to another person of a license without affording the applicant notice or hearing, except...(2) the board may, on its own initiative or in response to an objection or protest, hold a hearing to ascertain the reaction of the public or a local governing body to an application if a hearing is not required under this subsection;"

Staff Rec.:

Hold a public hearing; rescind prior approval with delegation and deny the application with a 180 day abeyance.

**Background:** The renewal application was approved with delegation at the March 31 and April 1, 2020 meeting. The Municipality of Anchorage protests due to pending payment in full of taxes owed to the Municipality and certification from the Building Safety Official.

The licensee should be notified that under 3 AAC 304.145(h), this abeyance period may not be extended or renewed.

This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

Note: This is not an accusation or a criminal complaint.

On 1-26-19 you participated an event called The Best of Alaska. The event did have a Special Events Permit which was obtained by Beans Cafe. Having a Special Events Caterer's Permit allows the holder to sell or serve beer and wine at the event. It does not allow for the selling or serving spirits. When questioned whether you sold and served spirits, you admitted to serving vodka based beverage samples and selling eight 750ml bottles of your product for off premises consumption. The organizer of the event was the Anchorage Daily News. Due to the lack of your due diligence regarding the type of permit that had been obtained, you violated Title IV.

Your attention is directed to AS 04.11.170: Distillery license, AS04.11.240: Special events permit, AS04.16.150: Licensee responsible for violation, AS04.21.030: Responsibility of licensee, agent, and employees and Anchorage Municipal Code 10.50.015: Prohibited acts (section S)

We were told this was handled by ADN. Suprinted email and letter.

You are directed to respond in writing to this Notice of Violation within 10 days of receipt to explain what action you have taken to prevent a re-occurrence of this violation. FAILURE TO RESPOND TO THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION WITHIN 10 DAYS WILL RESULT IN YOUR APPREARANCE, EITHER IN PERSON OR TELEPHONICALLY, BEFORE THE ABC BOARD AT THEIR NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING.

\*Please send your response to the address below and include your alcohol license number in your response.

3 AAC 304.525 (B) provides that upon receipt of a Notice of Violation, a licensee may request to appear before the Director and be heard regarding the Notice of Violation. The request must be made within ten days after receipt of the Notice and the Director must grant an appearance within ten days after receipt of a request. A Licensee shall respond, either orally or in writing, to the Notice.



It was brought to our attention that your establishment was issued a Notice of Violation for your participation in the Best of Alaska event. We do understand the seriousness of the situation and I apologize for putting your license at risk. We understand that this honest mistake carries massive implications for our vendors. This was in no way our intention and I hope you know that we do understand the severity of the situation and that we are working on processes so that this does *NOT* happen in the future.

Here is what happened, and the plan we have put into motion to prevent this from happening in the future:

ADN obtained a special event permit with our charity partner. When the permit was approved, we filed it and continued planning the event. It wasn't until after the event, that we realized the oversight on our part, that it was a 'beer/wine' only event permit.

After conversations with AMCO we have a better understanding on how this permit works, and which type of permit we need to use for events when serving spirits in addition to beer/wine. We know who to contact for questions and plan on having a meeting with an AMCO representative, our licensee partner with all vendors (either collectively or individually, if needed) prior to the event. In future years, we will share the permit with all vendors, and in the event they need something additional, we can work together to assure everyone is operating within the correct regulations.

On behalf of the Best of Alaska Event and ADN, I would like to apologize that this mistake happened. Please let us know if there is anything that we can do to assist in this process.

This memo is in response to a notice of violation (NOV) issued to Alaskan Spirits, LLC, AM19-0046, relating to pricing and marketing violations. On 1-10-19 I went to Alaska Spirits Distillery in response to an anonymous complaint regarding the giving away of free alcohol with the purchase of a shot glass.

Once I arrived at the establishment, I purchased the shoot glass and was given a tasting of three types of vodka. My further instructions were to see if they are serving more than 2 ounces, which they were not. While settling my bill, the bartender told me about their club. If you joined, you received a bottle of their product a month and 10% of drinks. Nothing was mentioned about merchandise.

After I left, I received a text message from Alaskan Distillery stating I had 29 points. For every \$1.00 spent, you received one point. "Members \$1.00 of Craft Cocktails, 1 Point". The message also depicted that members do receive 10% off merchandise. Also advertised in violation of pricing and marketing, for 100 points, "Cocktail on us!"


Alaskan Spirits LLC, responded to the on 1-24-19, that the notice was inaccurate and they give 10% off merchandise only. In print her response is accurate. When the program was being explained to me, I heard 10% of drinks when you come in.

In closing, I could have heard her wrong at the premises, but in print, they are advertising members get a \$1.00 of Craft Cocktails and a free Cocktail upon reaching 100 points. All violations of pricing and marketing.




