Alcohol Application Statistics

There are 8 new applications and 31 transfer applications to be considered on this agenda.

Permit Application Statistics & Information

Since June 1st to August 1st, we have received a total of 60 permit applications for events around the state. Out of the 60, only 6 of those were canceled. Licensees for 4 of those applications opted to apply for the AB-15: Temporary Licensed Premises Change. the remaining 2 canceled their events due to the rise in positive cases of Covid-19.
