**RE:** City of Bethel Resolution Request

Members of the Board,

Attached is a July 28, 2020 resolution passed by the City of Bethel. The City of Bethel resolution is requesting the Alcohol Beverage Control Board consider restricting within the City of Bethel the amounts of curbside pickup of alcohol sold by restaurants and eating places and only if the order of beer or wine accompanies an order or a meal, is prepared by the licensee on the premises, and that the food purchased at the retail price is at least 50% of the retail price of the alcohol purchase which accompanies the order.

In April of this year the ABC passed the home curbside and home delivery of beer and wine for with a food order. Curbside pickup did not have a limit to the amount of alcohol whereas the home deliver provision allowed for:

- Only bona fide restaurant or eating places (including those who hold beverage dispensary licenses and other qualified license types that possess restaurant designation permits)
- Only beer, wine, or cider can be included with the food order
- The delivery order must have food prepared by the licensee
- The value of the beer or wine purchased in the delivery cannot be more than twice the value of the food (e.g.: if \$25 of food is purchased, the value of the alcohol in that order must not exceed \$50).

The City of Bethel is requesting that the board consider giving them the same, or similar, provisions alcohol amount restrictions for curbside food delivery. The ABC's Board authority to do so is fully dependent on the Governor's suspension order, which does not require a food purchase for curbside pickup.

Additionally, AMCO has recently received an inquiry by a licensee who is approved to serve food and alcohol curbside and who was also asking about the reasonable amount of alcohol to accompany the curbside food orders.

The ABC may consider passing a resolution to request the Governor to modify his suspension order so that the ABC can then propose regulations to set out curbside limitations that mirror home delivery limitations.

# CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA

## Resolution #20-09

### **A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING THE ALASKA ALCOHOL & MARIJUANA CONTROL OFFICE PROHIBIT SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY MEANS OF CURBSIDE PICKUP AND HOME DELIVERY UNLESS THE SALES ARE ACCOMPANIED BY THE SALE OF A MEAL**

**WHEREAS**, on October 1, 2019, the City of Bethel voted to adopt Local Option identified under Alaska Statute 04.11.491(a)(2)(A), to prohibit the sale of alcoholic beverages except through a restaurant or eating place license;

**WHEREAS**, Alaska Statute 04.11.100 authorizes a restaurant or eating place license to sell beer and wine for consumption only on the licensed premises;

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, the governor declared a public health disaster emergency under AS 26.23.020 due to the spread of COVID -19; on April 14, 2020, the governor suspended a number of provisions of Title 4 of the Alaska Statutes in response to the public health disaster emergency;

**WHEREAS**, on April 16, 2020, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board issued emergency regulations, effective through August 13, 2020, regarding the governor's suspension of these Title 4 statutes;

**WHEREAS**, on July 16, 2020, the Alcohol Beverage Control Board extended the emergency regulations through November 15, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, by emergency regulation, the suspension of AS 04.11.100, Restaurant and Eating Place Licenses, is permitted only to the extent necessary to allow for (1) curbside pickup of alcohol; and (2) delivery of beer and wine when included with an order of food being delivered by a licensed restaurant or eating place establishment;

**WHEREAS**, on May 22, 2020, the governor lifted all corona-virus related restrictions on bars and restaurants, allowing them to re-open without capacity limits just as they were prior to the virus; however many members of the community are still wanting to maintaining social distancing in these trying times;

**WHEREAS**, the Bethel City Council supports our small businesses and would like to find a solution that upholds the community's vote to operate under local option, but also provides local businesses the revenue they need to remain open to the public; and


**WHEREAS**, by permitting the continued sales of alcohol by curbside pickup and delivery, but only with the purchase of a meal with a retail price of at least fifty percent of the retail price of the alcohol purchase, the Bethel City Council will protect the People's local option vote by only permitting the sales of beer and wine from a restaurant and eating place license when a meal is also purchased, while also supporting continued operation of our local small businesses.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL:**

In addition to any other provisions required or enforced by the Alcohol Beverage Control Board, including emergency regulations,, the Bethel City Council, consistent with Bethel Municipal Code 5.08 and Alaska Statute Title 4, hereby requests the Alcohol Beverage Control Board permit home delivery and curbside pickup of alcohol sold by restaurant and eating place licensees within the City of Bethel, only if the order of beer or wine accompanies an order of a meal, prepared by the licensee or the bona fide restaurant on premises. As defined in the regulations, a meal shall mean: food purchased at a retail price that is at least fifty percent of the retail price of the alcohol purchase accompanying the order.


