FROM: Jane P. Sawyer, Regulations Specialist RE: Regulations Project –

Repackaging by Package Store

The board opened this regulations project at the January 2020 meeting. At the August 2020 meeting, the board sent out a revised version of the draft (which removed 'wine or distilled spirits' and 'barrels') out for public comment. The draft was out for public comment for about 45 days closing on October 9, 2020. One comment was received and it is attached.

The change to 3 AAC 304.365 would allow a Package Store to repackage not only beer but also cider from kegs into other containers for sale on the licensed premises to be consumed off the licensed premises. Another change made to this section is rewording language so the regulation is better understood.

Options for the board:

- vote to adopt
- amend and put out for public comment
- send back to staff for revisions
- close the project without action

Dear members of the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board:

The Alaska Cabaret, Hotel, Restaurant, and Retailers Association (CHARR) – as a representative of Alaska's alcohol industry as a whole – supports the regulation project which would amend the language in section 3 AAC 304.365 to allow package stores to repackage cider from kegs into other containers.

We do, however, recommend one minor change – which we do not believe will require this regulation project to be put back out for public comment – that would add some additional flexibility of the regulated alcohol industry. Please consider the attached track changes to the draft, which would allow for repackaging of beer or cider from other large containers (to include barrels) into other containers.
