Requested Action: Licensee is requesting an extension/medical waiver of fingerprint-release form-fee requirement deadline required for renewal and related, previously un-reported officer change.

**Statutory
And**

AS 04.06.090(b): "The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title."

AS 04.11.295(a): "An applicant for the issuance or transfer of a license or a conditional contractor's permit under this title shall submit to the board, with the application, the applicant's fingerprints and the fees required by the Department of Public Safety under **AS 12.62.160** for criminal justice information and a national criminal history record check. Except as provided under (c) of this section, the board may require an applicant for renewal of a license or a conditional contractor's permit under this title to submit fingerprints and pay the required fees. The board shall submit the fingerprints to the Department of Public Safety to obtain a report of criminal justice information under **AS 12.62** and a national criminal history record check under **AS 12.62.400**. The Department of Public Safety may submit the fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history record check. The board shall use the information obtained under this section in its determination of an applicant's qualification for issuance, transfer, or renewal of a license or a conditional contractor's permit."

Regulatory

AS 04.11.270(a)(1): "the information required for a new license or permit under **AS 04.11.260** except that proof of notice under **AS 04.11.310** is not required."

Authority:

AS 04.11.260(b): "A corporation applying for a license or permit shall provide the names and addresses of the president, vice-president, secretary, managing officer, and all stockholders who own 10 percent or more of the stock in the corporation, together with any other information required by the board."

Staff Rec.: Consider the licensee's request in accordance with Alaska statutes and regulations.

Background:

On December 10, 2019, licensee reported change of officers to Division of Corporations, Business & Professional Licensing. On October 27, 2020, Alcohol Marijuana Control Office (AMCO) received licensee renewal application. The renewal form reported previously undisclosed change of President, Vice President and Secretary officials. On November 3, 2020, licensee informed AMCO their Vice President is currently hospitalized out of state without power of attorney and therefore is unable to obtain Vice President's fingerprints into foreseeable future. On November 6, 2020, AMCO issued a

Notice of Violation for unreported change of officials.

In accordance with the regulation above, the licensee should have submitted new Vice President's fingerprints, AB08a form and \$48.25 fee along with other related reports of change by December 20, 2019.



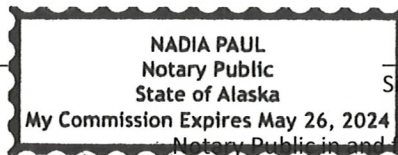
